General Classroom Rules:

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Class Work and Homework: Homework is assigned and to be done for each class session. It will be checked and reviewed the following day. You will not be penalized for mistakes in your homework; however you are expected to include **corrections** for all missed problems when we review them. You will be penalized for problems not attempted. **All work must be shown!**

Late Work: Late work will be accepted for **half** credit up to three days after the assignment was originally due. This does not pertain to excused absences as per school board policy.

Weighting of Assignments: Quizzes and tests, will be used to determine the majority of the semester grade. Class work, worksheets, and small daily quizzes may be given (as per the teacher's discretion). There will be a test given at the end of every major concept. The final course grade will be based on various traditional and alternative assessments, including the following:

1. Assessments (Tests, Quizzes, Projects):	60%
2. Homework/Class work/Notes/Warm-Ups:	40%
