



Dual Sports/Recreation/Team Sports/Individual Sports/Weight Training/H.O.P.E.

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DRESS REQUIREMENTS:

All students must wear the proper uniform to class: Plain white T-SHIRT (no Logo), or plain gray T-SHIRT, Black athletic shorts, socks & SNEAKERS. The P.E. Department recommends that you place your name in your clothes. NO SLIPPERS, FLIP-FLOPS, SANDALS, BOOTS, BACKLESS SHOES, BOAT SHOES, MUSCLE SHIRTS, TANK TOP T-SHIRTS, etc. All students are responsible for his/her personal belongings. Items of value be left at home. Student Athletes/JROTC/Band/Chorus in uniforms will be excused from participating on game days, but still must dress out and follow the class procedure in order to obtain a daily grade. Students dress out daily.

LOCK REQUIREMENTS:

Each student will be assigned a locker with a combination lock. **ALL LOCKERS AND LOCKS ARE THE PROPERTY OF PIPER HIGH SCHOOL. NO LOCKS MAY BE BROUGHT FROM HOME OR USED UNLESS ISSUED BY THE P.E. DEPARTMENT.**

All lockers are to be returned when the student leaves the course. Students will be charged \$10.00 for lost or not returned locks. Each student will be issued a small locker. **Long lockers are to be used ONLY during your P.E. class.** There will be random sweeps of long lockers

during lunch, before and after school. Items left in long lockers will be removed. This is a P.E. locker/NOT A BOOK locker.

ACCIDENTS:

Any injury is to be reported by the student IMMEDIATELY, even if it appears to be a minor in nature. The teacher will fill out an accident report and the parent will be notified.

GRADING:

At the end of the nine weeks, students will receive a letter grade ranging from an A to F following the Broward County School Board grading policy.

1. Students are expected to dress out properly and actively participate in class for the entire block.
2. Make-up work will be assigned for absences. It is the students responsibility to ask for the work the day they return.
3. Zero or lower grades will be given for the following:
 - Not being dressed out properly(as stated above in dress requirement)
 - Not participating in class or field activities.
 - Not sitting in assigned seat or line for attendance.
 - Disciplinary action taken by any of the physical education teachers for horse playing, profanity, leaving class area without permission.
 - Demonstrating an attitude that is inappropriate for class.
 - Using or displaying cell phones, ipods, headsets in the gym, classroom, athletic field, weight room, or fitness room is not permitted.
 - None of the above are permitted during class time.
4. Any injury is to be reported by the student IMMEDIATELY, even if it appears to be a minor.
5. Students are expected to dress out properly and actively participate in class for the entire block.
6. Make-up work will be assigned for absences. It is the students responsibility to ask for the work the day they return.

LOCKER ROOM PROCEDURES:

Students will have 7 minutes to dress for class before reporting to their assigned area for roll call. After the student dresses out they must report to their assigned area for attendance. Students should use the restroom during this time. If student is not in line for roll call they will be marked unexcused tardy and not dressed out. **NO BOOK BAGS, PURSES, CELL PHONES, IPODS, BACK PACKS, FOOD/DRINKS are permitted in the gym, classroom, athletic fields, weight room, and fitness room.** Students must be in the locker room when the tardy bell rings. Upon completion of class, students have 7 minutes to shower, change, and prepare for their next class. Students are to wait in the gym for the dismissal bell to ring. Students are to observe all safety rules while in the locker room. No horseplay is permitted.

Grading Scale by Percentage

All students will follow the guidelines set forth by Broward County Public Schools, the Code of Student Conduct Handbook, and Piper's attendance policy.

MEDICAL EXCUSES:

Students with medical problems should notify the guidance department and the teacher of any present medical condition. In the event a student cannot participate due to illness, he/she must present a written excuse from his/her guardian. Guardian notes will be honored for only 3 days. The student is still required to dress out, but not participate. After that, a doctor's note is required and the student is still required to dress out even though they are excused from participation. In addition they will be required to submit a one page summary on any current health or sport current event. This assignment is due the end of each block that they are excused.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES:

Prior to the start of class, students must turn their electronic devices off to avoid unnecessary classroom disruptions. NO BOOK BAGS, PURSES, CELL PHONES, IPODS, BACK PACKS, FOOD/DRINKS are permitted in the gym, classroom, athletic fields, weight room, and fitness room.

Pursuant to State Statute: 810.145

No cell phones with cameras, cameras and/or video recording devices are permitted in the locker room/restroom area.
