

Weighting of Assignments: Quizzes and tests, will be used to determine the majority of the semester grade. Class work, worksheets, and small daily quizzes may be given (as per the teacher's discretion). The final course grade will be based on various traditional and alternative assessments, including the following:

2. Homework/Classwork/Notes/Warm-Ups 40%
