Dear Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) Families:

Earlier today, you received information regarding your child's attendance via virtual learning, which needs to be clarified.

We understand there were situations where students were online with their classes on Monday – accessing Canvas the way they have done in the past – but were not counted for attendance.

For your child's **daily attendance** to be counted, he or she must now access Canvas by **first** signing in through Single Sign-On. Single Sign-On brings your child to the Clever portal, which allows him or her to access Canvas. If your student does not use Single-Sign-On, his or her attendance is not recorded. Single Sign-on can be accessed at sso.browardschools.com

BCPS wants to ensure your child is engaged in learning and able to access all the educational resources available. The District is monitoring engagement through Single Sign-On to help identify which students are in need of assistance with virtual learning. Additionally, if your child needs a computer device or internet access, contact your child's school.

Students currently enrolled at **Broward Virtual School**, will continue to be contacted by their teachers as usual, if their participation is not meeting expectations. **Also, VPK and PK students will not be contacted through the Attendance Office during the school closures associated with COVID-19.**
