Dear Parent or Guardian:

The Broward County Health Department (BCHD) confirmed Broward County has been identified as one of several areas experiencing a Hepatitis A outbreak.

Signs and Symptoms: A viral infection, which begins with an abrupt fever, discomfort, loss of appetite, nausea, abdominal cramping, followed within a few days by jaundice and flu-like symptoms.

Mode of Transmission: Person to person by oral fecal route.

Incubation Period: 15 to 50 days with an average of 28 to 30 days.

Prevention against Hepatitis A:

- Hepatitis A vaccination. Please contact your health provider for more information about the vaccine and who should be vaccinated.
- Practice good hand hygiene-including thoroughly washing hands after using the bathroom, changing diapers, and before preparing or eating food-plays an important role in preventing spread of Hepatitis A.

Should your child present any of the symptoms, we recommend that you consult your family healthcare provider.
