### International Academy for Newcomer English Language Learners

In 2018/19, the District's International Academy for Newcomer English Language Learners is expanding. Plantation High School will begin offering the International Colonel Academy this school year, following the successful pilot of the International Mustang Academy at McArthur High School last year. The program:

- Uses a school-within-a-school model to provide students with increased support during their transition to BCPS. This includes a strong focus on English language development and literacy skills.
- Offers a highly structured learning environment as students are grouped together during the school day for their core classes.
- Provides students with a team of teachers who are specially trained to assist English language learners with their unique needs and provide the support necessary to be successful in school.

BCPS provides English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) services for approximately 35,000 English language learners. BCPS is proud to be a diverse urban school district representing students from more than 200 countries and speaking more than 180 languages.

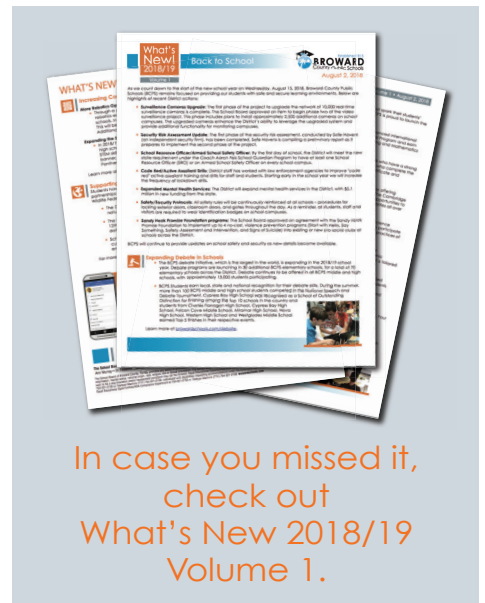
