ESSAY TOPIC: "Nearly a century ago, the FBI was created to investigate criminal activity that had begun to cross county and state lines. As America's crime problem evolved, so did the Bureau. Its mission grew and changed when national security and espionage threats came to the forefront. Today, criminal and terrorist threats increasingly have an international dimension. Jet travel, cell phones, and the Internet have made it a rare case that does not cross international boundaries.

Immediately following 9/11, the FBI's number one priority became the prevention of terrorist attacks. This required a systematic approach to examining all aspects of the Bureau operations. Everything from how we communicate inside the FBI to how we communicate outside to other agencies; how we refocus on terrorism but continue to uphold our other responsibilities; how we disseminate our intelligence information, yet protect it from foreign spies who want to know what we know."

Given the evolution of threats, does the FBI need to change? The next question is what is needed so that the FBI can successfully carry out its new mission? How do you play a role in this change? What can you offer to the evolution and future changes of the FBI?

Code of Conduct Agreement

FBI Youth Academy Scholarship Recipients are hand-selected for a unique, one-of-a-kind education experience. Your conduct and character are extremely important, as they represent who you are, as well as represent the FBI, Miami Dade College, and The FBI Miami Citizens Academy Alumni Association.

If you are selected as an FBI Youth Academy Scholarship Recipient you are expected to:

- 1. Attend school every day and be on time and prepared to learn.
- 2. Give advanced notice if late or unable to make class.
- 3. Show respect to colleagues, adults, and property at all times.
- 4. Address all adults as "Sir" "Mr." "Mrs." "Ms." "Special Agent" "Officer" etc.
- 5. No use vulgar, obscene, and derogatory language. ZERO TOLERANCE
- 6. Work to the best of your ability, striving toward the highest level of achievement possible.
- 7. React to direction in a respectful, positive manner.
- 8. Accept responsibility for your actions.
- 9. Conduct yourself as a representative of your family and school, holding yourself to the highest standards of conduct, demeanor, and sportsmanship.
- 10. Alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs are prohibited.
- 11. Refrain from fighting, arguing, or exhibiting violent actions.
- 12. No sleeping during class.
- 13. NO texting or talking on <u>cell phones</u> during class (cell use allowed ONLY at breaks).

Student Dress Code: Students are expected to give proper attention to personal cleanliness and to dress appropriately.

- 1. Students must wear Academy Shirt along with khaki pants.
- 2. Wear covered footwear at all times. (Sneakers or casual shoes)
- 3. Grooming and appearance should be appropriate and not interfere with the educational process.
- 4. Gang-style clothing is prohibited. No baggy pants.
- 5. Ensure that underwear is completely covered with outer clothing.
- 6. No wearing of hats while inside the classroom (except for a medical or religious purpose.
- 7. No large hoop earrings please.

Designing Success Tracking Program Agreement

FBI Youth Academy Scholarship Recipients are hand-selected for a unique, one-of-a-kind education experience. As part of our on-going efforts to enhance the program, collect data for future funding, and keep in touch with our scholarship recipients, we will be tracking the education and career goals of each student.

The "Tracking at a Glance" software allows us the opportunity to track students after they graduate the FBI Youth Academy program. Our goal is to determine what impact the program has on a student's academic and career goals.

Students will be tracked over a period of 6-8 years (depending on high school grade level when participating in the program). No social security numbers are retained; however, certain contact and personal information is required (physical address, e-mail, telephone, gender, ethnicity, etc.) Over the tracking period, students will participate in surveys pertaining to academic and career goals. The program will also provide information so that mentoring opportunities and alumni activities can be offered.

The Designing Success Tracking Program is administered through the FBI Miami Citizens Academy Program. All information is kept confidential and will not be disclosed to second or third parties.
