Scholarships

1. Most scholarships can be found in Naviance.

Steps on locating scholarships in Naviance:

• Log into Naviance from Clever

- Go to the College Tab (top right)
- Click on Scholarship & Money
- Click on Scholarship List
- Click on Local & Regional Scholarships (top left)
- 1. Scholarship Bulletin on Brace Website (you can access through school's website)
- 2. Scholarships are also emailed and posted on Canvas (make sure email is updated in Naviance)

Fall: August to December

 Use your Family Connection account to explore colleges, majors, career and apply for scholarships.

Follow the steps below to log in to Family connections:

- 1. Go to your school's Family Connection website https://connection.naviance.com/plantationhs
- 2. Username (username is the Student Number (ex: 06......)
- 3. Password (password is student's birthdate in the following format: MM/DD/YYYY (include slashes!)
- Create a list of schools you would like to apply to atleast 4!

Materials needed for applications:

- 1. Online Application (include essay)
- 2. Official Sat/ACT scores sent from College Board/ACT student account
- 3. Official High School transcript or SSAR

4. Payment: Pay the application fee OR send in fee waiver

A: Fee waiver: If you are eligible for free and reduce lunch, you have waivers four college applications in your College Board account online. Students that also have free or reduce lunch qualify for two ACT and SAT waivers as well. You can pick them up in BRACE office, Room 160 upon request or send an email request.

- Fee waivers available in the Brace Office, room 160 for students on Free and Reduced lunch (SAT-2 Free Waivers) and (ACT-4 Free Waivers)

<u>October 1st:</u> Complete 2019-2020 FAFSA: Free Application for Federal Student Aid. *If you are starting college in the summer, you must also complete the 2020-2021 FAFSA*.

- You must create a Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID Online for you and one of your parent or guardians in order to fill out a FAFSA application. Write down your information and securely place it somewhere safe, because you will need it again for future reference.

Spring: January to June

- Regularly check Naviance and keep applying for scholarships
- Inform Mrs. Solomon, the Brace Advisor about any college acceptances, financial aid awards and scholarships won. *Bring proof of your award to the BRACE office room 160 or email it to her*
- April 1st: Make your final decision about your postsecondary plans and participate in Academics Signing Day.
- Complete your Senior Graduation Survey in Naviance informing the school about your postsecondary plans and request your final transcript to receive your Cap and Gown.
