READING ACCROSS BROWARD

If your child has not started logging the books for Reading Across Broward there is still plenty of time to participate. This years books can be logged on Beanstack. (Instructions are below.) Kindergarten – Second Grade students who log 100 books and Third – Fifth Grade students who log 50 books by **April 1, 2019**will earn a Reading medal at the end of the year.

Students access Beanstack through sso.browardschools.com. Login (The name is your child's 06# and the password is your child's birthdate Pmm/dd/yyyy). Select the "Beanstack" option. Click on the "Log Reading and Activities" button at the top left corner. As your child logs books, he or she will earn virtual badges and special recognition.

There is also a Beanstack app. To use it visit the App Store or Play Store and download the Beanstack app. Login (The name is your child's 06#, the password is your child's birthdate mmddyy). Go to "Log" at the bottom, select the "+" button at the top, select add to Archive. Scan the books ISBN number/barcode or enter the book title. Add the date the book was read. If it asks for the last page enter the last page in the book. Remember to "mark as complete" and click SAVE.

WESTCHESTER READS

Westchester Reads is still going strong. Students who read eight books and hand in the log with the paw prints may choose a book or another prize from the prize cart in the Media Center. (Remember to log the books students read for this program on their Reading Across Broward log, too).

CODE.ORG COURSES

In December students participated in Hour of Code but did you know your student can continue to learn about coding by using free courses through their Broward single sign on accounts. Go to sso.browardschools.com, choose the Code.org option. There are courses for each grade level and students can work on any course at their own pace. 
