

PUT IT DOWN...IT'S THE LAW

The Coral Springs Police Department is committed to ensuring our residents and visitors are aware of and well-informed about the new distracted driving laws for the State of Florida.

BEFORE YOU DECIDE TO REACH FOR YOUR CELLPHONE WHILE DRIVING, YOU SHOULD KNOW THE FOLLOWING:

- **Effective July 1, 2019:** Motorists may be stopped by a law enforcement officer for texting and driving while the car is in motion
- Effective October 1, 2019: Cellphone devices can only be used in a HANDS-FREE manner when driving in designated <u>SCHOOL ZONES</u> and active workzone areas in Florida.

Children deserve our full attention. Any form of distracted driving is unsafe, but in a school zone (including school property) where children are likely to be present is especially dangerous.
