



BCAA North County Coach of the Year

Not since 1992 had a Blanche Ely girls basketball team won a state championship.

So, when Henry McNabb was named to coach the team entering the 2019-20 season, expectations were high, a state title would be a sure thing.

After back-to-back state titles the previous two season at Somerset Prep, McNabb delivered, as the Tigers won the Class 6A state title following a 51-36 victory over Wekiva.

McNabb has been named the BCAA North County Coach of the Year.

He also became the third girls' basketball coach from Broward to win at least three straight state championships, joining Marcia Pinder (Dillard) and Abby Ward (South Broward).

The high expectations were rightfully dropped in McNabb's lap with the handful of talent on the Tigers roster to start the 2019-20 season.

Returning was high scoring junior Ja'Leah Williams along with the majority of the previous seasons roster. Joining the Tigers from the championship Somerset Prep team were Michiyah Simmons, Mya Kone and Zaria Blake.

Despite the pressure, McNabb found the balance to finish with a 28-6 record that included multiple victories over district rivals Dillard, Nova and St. Thomas Aguinas.

With all the key starters returning next season, McNabb will face the challenge of another state title run.



BCAA South County Co-Coach of the Year

This was a clear example of the unexpected.

When Alen Hardy took over as coach for the Western High boys' basketball team the future success of the program was uncertain.

Hardy had replaced former coach Kenneth Kelly following a 19-10 season, to become an assistant at American Heritage.

Success was closer than most would have thought.

Hardy guided the Wildcats to an 18-8 season, a berth into the BCAA Big 8 tournament and for the first time in school history a berth into the regional finals.

Hardy has been named the BCAA South County Co-coach of the Year.

He was also the Sun Sentinel Coach of the Year in 2020.

The success of the Wildcats 201-9-20 season nearly went beyond all expectations falling short of a state semifinal berth for the first time in school history.

Western took eventual Class 7A state champion Miramar to the edge of defeat before falling 37-35. It was also the Wildcats first regional final appearance.

Western won the District 13-7A title with a 56-53 victory over Cypress Bay. It was their first such title since 2014.

They had lost to the Lightning in a regional semifinal the previous year.

The district title was followed with a 65-51 victory over Miami Columbus in a regional quarterfinal and 61-51 win over Miami High in a regional semifinal.



BCAA South County Coach of the Year

The goal is always to get there and win a state championship. At the start of the 2019-20 high school boys' basketball season, Miramar High was one of many with the same dream.

Under coach Tramaine Stevens, those dreams finally came true as the Patriots won the first boys basketball title in the schools 49-year history with a 66-51 victory over Seminole in a Class 7A title game at the RP Funding Center in early March.

For that achievement Stevens has been named the BCAA South County Co-Coach of the Year.

Stevens, who just completed his fifth season as the Patriots coach was also named the 2020 Class 7A Florida Dairy Farmers Boys Basketball Coach of the Year.


The Patriots were led by forward Deshawn Jean-Charles 25 points to lead Miramar in state final game.

Stevens had led Miramar to the 2018 state semifinal before falling to Wellington. The Patriots found the way to the 2020 final following at 59-55 in overtime victory over Oak Ridge.

Steven and Miramar finished the season 24-6, while winning 13 of their final 14 games, including the last seven.

Stevens has a career record of 102-41 at Miramar after taking over the program in 2015.
