MEMBERSHIP & ATTENDANCE

• Membership/Enrollment Requirements

- ✓ *Enrolled* at least *one day* during survey week
 - Student withdraws prior to survey week NOT eligible for FTE
 - Student enrolls after survey week NOT eligible for FTE

Attendance FTE Eligibility Requirement

- ✓ Student must be **physically present** a minimum of one day during the 11-day attendance window.
 - External Suspension is considered absent, as they are not receiving academic instruction.



STUDENT - FTE ELIGIBLITY

Ensures only those students that meet the FLDOE FTE Attendance Requirement are REPORTED for FTE funding

✓ FTE Eligibility OptiSpool Report (ZSDBD098)

- Check OptiSpool DAILY during SURVEY WEEK
- Eligibility Status based on the student's A15 Attendance Panel in TERMS
 - Do not update the A08 Panel in TERMS Program will override based on attendance in TERMS
 - Program updates the student's eligibility status once student is recorded as present in TERMS
- Only those schools with students not meeting the FTE Attendance Requirement will receive this report.
 - If your school does not have this report in OptiSpool, all students meet the attendance requirement.
- Notify the School Administration of any student listed on the ZSDBD098.
- Check OptiSpool the school day immediately following date certain. Students on this report were NOT reported for FTE funding.
 - Keep with your FTE documentation

Hourly Equivalent - 180-Day School Year

Instructional time impacts FTE!

- ✓ BCPS operates on a 180-day school year calendar
 - √ 6 early release days reduces instructional time by 3 days
 - ✓ Total instructional days is 177 days

Hourly Equivalent of 180 Days of Instruction Full-Time Equivalent (FTE)

- ✓ Kindergarten through 3rd Grade
 - √720 Instructional hours per year
 - $\sqrt{(720/177)}$ x 60 = 244 minutes per day or 1,220 minutes per week
- √4th through 12th Grade
 - √ 900 Instructional hours per year
 - $\sqrt{(900/177)}$ x 60 = 305 minutes per day or 1,525 minutes per week
- ✓ FLDOE can approve instructional hours flexibility
 - √ Hurricanes, natural disasters
 - √ For health and safety issues, such as pandemics



Shared FTE & Recalibration

FLDOE combines all FTE for students reported in multiple Florida public school districts

Maximum .50 UFTE earned per survey
Maximum 1.0 UFTE for the school year
(excluding Survey 1 & 4 for DJJ sites)

FTE IS SHARED WHEN...

- More than one Florida district reports a student for FTE funding, this includes virtual schools, such as Florida Virtual.
 - Membership and Attendance requirements must be met

FLDOE matches students based on their demographic records, which are reviewed by the District. Recommend the following:



When available, include student's middle name

Always indicate the previous district on the A03

Confirm prior school withdrew student

Enrollment & FTE Panels in TERMS

✓ L03 Panel - Enrollment Counts

- Prior Day Enrollment
- Students Active on A03 Panel in TERMS

✓ C13 Panel – FTE Earnings

- Prior Day FTE Earnings (Up until Date Certain)
 - Does NOT include any reduction for SHARED FTE, FLVS or Null FTE
- Local TE2028 reflects the C13 Panel in TERMS

√ Compare the L03 Panel to C13 Panel (TE2028)

- C13 Panel multiplied by 2 (should be near the equivalent of L03 Panel)
- Reasons why enrollment is not the equivalent of the C13 Panel
 - Non-ESE VPK, Hospital Homebound Students
 - High School College Dual Enrollment
 - Awaiting upload from colleges for Non-Embedded Dual Enrollment Courses
 - Students with incomplete schedules or non-funded courses (999)

✓ TS7006 generates from the A10 Scheduling Panel in TERMS

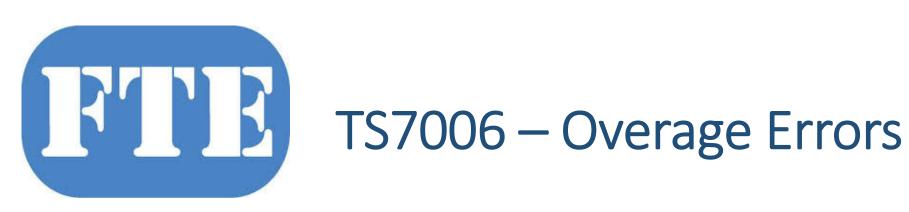
- Student(s) without a schedule on the A10 Panel will NOT appear on this report
- Corresponds with C13 FTE Earning Panel in TERMS
- Confirm student count to your L03 Enrollment Panel in TERMS

✓ Schools are to confirm each student is generating 0.5000 FTE

- Reasons why a student is generating less than 0.5000 FTE
 - Total weekly minutes less than minimum requirement for full FTE
 - Student missing courses, or courses reported as non-funded (999)
 - Not a full-time student

✓ Schools are to compare with the <u>BS</u>7006 Report

- School of Instruction is different from School of Enrollment
 - Hospital Homebound, Dual Enrollment (Broward Technical Colleges)
 - Another school has an active student schedule on the A10 Schedule Panel in TERMS
 - If error, contact other school immediately

State Processing & Final Close

- ✓ FLDOE runs two edit processes: State Processing & Final Close
 - Corrections <u>made by State Processing</u> will appear on the survey's <u>preliminary</u> Recalibrated FTE reports
 - Corrections <u>made by the Final Close</u> will appear on the survey's *final* Recalibrated FTE reports
 - <u>Null FTE</u> errors <u>not corrected by the Survey's Final Close</u> will result in <u>loss of FTE Funding</u>

FLDOE NULL REPORTS

FTE correction priority as could result in loss of FTE Funding

- **√70.766** Student Course Records to be Nulled by Edit
- **√** 60.984 Student Course Records Nulled by Edit

- ✓ Print the C13 FTE Earnings Panel
- ✓ Print the LO3 Enrollment Panels

FTE Attendance Reports

- ✓ Monitor I&T Bulletins for instructions on how to pull FTE Attendance Reports
- ✓ Final FTE Attendance Report must be signed and dated by the Principal

Run the following OptiSpool Reports once they become available

- ✓ TE2028 FTE-2 School Summary
- ✓ BS7006 FTE-1 by Class
- ✓TS7006 FTE-1 by Class (pdf this report Do Not Print)
- √71.345 FTE Counts (School's Recalibrated Earned FTE)
