Executive Summary November 6, 2019, School Board Operational Meeting K-2 Special Revenue Grants Fund Amendment #1 As of October 31, 2019

Special Revenue Grants Fund Amendment is submitted to the School Board pursuant to State Board Administrative Rule 6A-1.007. This Amendment is for the purpose of updating the Broward County School District Budget for estimated revenues and appropriation changes in the Special Revenue Grants Fund.

This amendment incorporates changes in:

- 1. PELL funding for 254 students attending Atlantic, McFatter and Sheridan technical colleges.
- 2. New funding received from Career Source Broward to support the Construction and Building Trades Apprenticeship Program. Students will earn high school credentials, industry credentials and job placement.
- 3. Funding received from Career Source Broward with the Worker Incumbent Training grants. Broward College will deliver coursework to teachers to assist with meeting the requirements for Florida Professional Educator's Certificate.
