### **Requested Action**

Approve Capital Fund Amendment #3 changes in revenue and appropriations.

**District-zone impact:** District-wide.

## Impact if the Board Voted Yes or No

### If the Board votes "Yes"

From Capital Reserves, staff would:

• Fund implementation costs for SAP ARIBA and SAP SuccessFactors enterprise resource planning software from Capital.

#### If the Board votes "No"

• Capital will not fund SAP ARIBA and SAP SuccessFactors enterprise resource planning software. The cost will remain in the General Fund and may impact the fund balance.

### Background/History

On October 17, 2023, the Board approved the contracts for SAP Ariba (OO-4) and SAP SuccessFactors (OO-5). This item moves the allowable implementation costs to Capital. The fiscal year 2023-24 implementation costs are \$3,650,000. These items should have indicated that the funds were coming from the Capital budget to allow the General Fund to sustain funding for District IT software/hardware needs not eliaible for Capital funding.

### Alignment to 2027 Goals and Guardrails

Guardrail 4: Accountability - This item is presented to the School Board to comply with statutory requirements per Fla. Admin. Code R. 6A-1.007.

### Measurable Outcome(s)/Return on Investment

Realignment of cost to Capital will improve the District's General Fund balance position.

The financial impact of this item is \$3,650,000 from the Capital Reserve.
