

Food and Nutrition Services for Students and Families

Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) will provide food to BCPS students their families. Breakfast will be offered from 8 – 10 a.m., and lunch will be offered from 11 a.m. – 1 p.m.

The meals will be provided during regular school day closures, which are:
