Prekindergarten programs are available for children with disabilities.

All services are provided at no cost to parents.



Child Find Provides:

- Free assessment in the areas of speech, language, motor development, vision, hearing, and learning.
- Information about other programs available in the community for preschool children with special needs.
- Professional consultation for parents.
- Books, videos and learning kits for loan to parents of children with special needs through the Florida Diagnostic & Learning Resources System (FDLRS) Media Center at 754-321-3428.

Students that are eligible include those with the following disabilities: Speech and Language Impaired, Developmentally Delayed, Autism, Deaf and Hard of Hearing, Visually Impaired, Physically Impaired, Cognitively Impaired.


