SUBJECT: **FLORIDA INVENTORY OF SCHOOL HOUSES CAPACITY UPDATE REPORT**

Attached for your information is the Florida Inventory of School Houses (FISH) Capacity Update Report dated April 1, 2019, that was updated from the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) FISH data. The permanent capacity remains unchanged for high schools.

Also, the portable capacity at the elementary and middle schools remain unchanged for Fiscal Year 2019-20. The portables capacity at high schools decreased due to the location of the new building construction at Charles W. Flanagan High School and Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School. Funding was not allocated in the District Educational Facility Plant Fiscal Years 2018-2019 to 2022-2023 for the demolition of portables due to the significant financial constraints the District is currently under.

Also attached is the current Portable Classroom Counts Summary Report. The difference between the September 4, 2018 Capacity Update Report and this April 1, 2019 Capacity Update Report are shown in the following Tables. Table 1 is a summary of the permanent FISH capacity changes, and Table 2 is a summary of the relocatable FISH capacity changes. Also attached is the CORE Dining Report.

Please be advised that the Facility Planning and Real Estate Department is working with the Information and Demographics and Student Assignments Department to update the Planning Tool with related data from this Report.
