Interested applicants should review the criteria below for participation procedures for the LEAD Program

<u>Phase I: Documentation, Résumé, Essay and Principal Feedback</u> – <u>Please note submission procedures have changed</u> Please log into OSPA Central to complete the online Phase I application. Your site principal must give you access to "LEADERSHIP APPLICANTS." Please have the following documents ready to upload:

- An experiential résumé aligned to the current Florida Principal Leadership Standards describing leadership roles and experiences beyond the classroom
- Three (3) evaluation documents showing a <u>final overall</u> "Effective" or "Highly Effective" rating. The 2018/2019 evaluation rating must be from a Broward County Public/Charter School. The other two "Effective" or "Highly Effective" evaluations must be within the past five school years (2013/2014 2017/2018). All evaluation documents MUST BE final evaluations which include BOTH instructional practice scores and VAM scores for an overall score
- A copy of the applicant's current Florida Teaching Certificate from the Department of Education showing Educational Leadership (Five-Year Professional Certificate must be current and in good standing)
- An essay written to the prompt: Describe how you have worked to ensure that instruction beyond your own classroom is appropriately rigorous and aligned to the state standards. (two page maximum, twelve point font, double-spaced)

A leadership profile will be sent directly to the school principal of those applicants meeting program qualifications. The mentor principal will score the applicant on a set of leadership indicators aligned to the Florida Principal Leadership Standards, which will be applied to Phase I scores.

Phase II: Writing Sample and Interview

Applicants with Phase I scores meeting or exceeding an identified score will be invited to attend a session at the Leadership Development Department office to complete a timed writing sample and interview.

Phase III: Presentation and Interview

Applicants with Phase II scores meeting or exceeding an identified score will be invited to attend a session at the Leadership Development Department office to present instructional leadership experiences and interview.

Phase IV: Selection into the LEAD Program

Applicants selected for the LEAD Program will be notified in writing prior to the completion of the 2019 - 20 school year.
