

## Broward County Public Schools (BCPS), Data Snapshot **Promotion Rates, 2013-14**




# Promotion rates of third-grade BCPS students Black, Hispanic, and White by gender, 2013-14.



### **Promotion At A Glance**

- At the elementary, middle, and high school grade levels and subgroups, District-wide promotion rates were stable across the three years of the study; 97.9% in 2011-12, 97.7% in 2012-13, and 97.9% in 2013-14.
- Grades 1 to 3 show some fluctuations in promotion rates across the three years of the study due to criterion based promotion requirements.
- Middle and High school promotion rates were greater than (98%) across the three years of the study.
- Ninth-grade students registered the highest promotion rates (99%) for the 2013-14 school year.
- Third-grade Black male students evidenced the lowest promotion rates for the 2013-14 school year at (89%). The other racial/gender groups ranged from 93 98% for this grade.
- The innovation zones with the highest promotion rates were Nova (99.4%, n=4,668), Cypress Bay (99.3%, n =12,216), and West Broward (99.3%, n=5,238).
