SUBJECT: HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION RATES, 2015-16

On December 16, 2016, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) released Federal graduation rates for Florida and the 67 Florida school districts. State and district data are located online at the FDOE Education Information & Accountability Services Website:

### Highlights from this data include:

- Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) achieved its highest graduation rate since Florida adopted the Federal Uniform Graduation Rate method in 2010-11.
- BCPS Federal graduation rate was **78.7% in 2015-16**, which is an increase of 2.1 percentage points from 76.6% in 2014-15.
- BCPS traditional high schools achieved a graduation rate of **92.2% in 2015-16**, which exceeded the 91.7% achieved in 2014-15.
- Black (70.6%), Hispanic (81.3%), and White (86.1%) students improved their graduation rates. **Black students showed a greater improvement in graduation rate, closing the gap with White students by 2.4 percentage points**.
- 23 traditional high schools had a graduation rate of 90% or higher.
- 23 of 33 traditional high schools improved or maintained their graduation rate.
- South Broward High School increased their graduation rate by more than five percentage points compared to 2014-15. William T. McFatter Technical College, College Academy, and Pompano Beach High School achieved graduation rates of 100%.
- Florida's Federal graduation rate was 80.7% in 2015-16, which is an increase of 2.8 percentage points from 77.9% in 2014-15.


<u>Table 1</u> displays the historical graduation rates for Florida's five largest districts and the State overall. In 2015-16, Broward had a graduation rate of 78.7, which was lower than Hillsborough, Miami-Dade, Orange, Palm Beach, and Florida. All of the big five districts increased their graduation rates by over two percentage points.

<u>Figure 1</u> illustrates the five-year historical graduation rates for BCPS traditional high schools, BCPS overall (including centers and charter schools), and Florida. BCPS traditional schools achieved graduation rates that were consistently higher than the state, reaching 92.2% in 2015-16.

<u>Table 2</u> shows the graduation rates for the major race/ethnicity groups served in BCPS. The graduation rate increased for all three groups; however, Black students showed a greater increase than did their peers. In 2015-16, the gap between Black and White students decreased by 2.4 percentage points and the gap between Hispanic and White students was stable.

<u>Appendix A</u> shows the graduation rates for the five most recent cohorts attending Broward. Review of the appendix shows that **23 traditional high schools had a graduation rate of 90% or higher.** Twenty-three of BCPS' traditional high schools improved or maintained their graduation rate. South Broward High School improved their graduation rate by more than five percentage points. William T. McFatter Technical College, College Academy, and Pompano Beach High School all attained 100% graduation rates.
