REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ Candidates must be in their last year or concentration year of a graduate program.
- ▶ Require the completion of 710 hours including your program's required hours.
- ▶ Complete application, including a statement of interest.

- Award of the BCPS School-Based Mental Health Certification
- Preferred hiring status at BCPS
- Free supervision for licensure
- Reimbursement for preparatory classes and professional testing exam fees
- Opportunity for stipend
