Join the AmeriCorps Recovery Ambassadors Program.**



Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) is hiring caring, capable individuals as AmeriCorps Recovery Ambassadors tutors and mentors for its students. AmeriCorps Recovery Ambassadors will provide personal attention and support to students throughout the District to help them during non-instructional time and personalization periods.

Benefits of becoming an AmeriCorps Recovery Ambassador at BCPS include:

- A living allowance provided to all members with an amount related to the level of service a member performs.
- Hands-on experience in a professional setting working with a school district and community organizations.
- Ambassadors may qualify for student loan forbearance during their term of service.
- Ambassadors can have employment outside of the time commitment to their service term.
- After successfully completing a term of service, Ambassadors are eligible to receive a Segal AmeriCorps Education Award, which can be used to repay qualified student loans or cover education costs at qualified institutions of higher learning. The education award may be used up to seven years after service has ended.

A single term of service as an AmeriCorps Recovery Ambassador involves:

- Three Quarter Time Service - a minimum of 1,200 hours of service over 11 months
- A living allowance for the term of \$10,152.00
- Qualification to earn an education award on completion of \$4,336.50
