Mr. Monteleone, called the meeting to order. Roll call was done.

The first item of business on the agenda was the approval of minutes for the last (2) two meetings held on February 21, 2020 and May 8, 2020. A motion was made to approve, seconded and passed unanimously at the end of the meeting.

The second item of business on the agenda was presented by Mr. Kyle Jones, Investment Advisor with PFM. Mr. Jones gave a thorough COVID-19 monthly market update. He discussed COVID-19's Impact on the Economy and Public Fund Investment Portfolios.

The next item on the agenda was presented by Mr. Steven Alexander, Investment Advisor with PFM. Mr. Alexander presented the quarterly investment report with the Committee. He reviewed the quarterly market update, asset allocation, long term operating 1-3 year Fund, long term operating 1-5 year Fund and GOB Series 2015 Funds.

The next item on the agenda was presented by Mr. David Moore, Financial Advisor with PFM. Mr. Moore presented a market update. He discussed tax-exempt interest rates, taxable interest rates and market conditions with the Committee.

The next item on the agenda was presented by Ms. Laura Howe, Financial Advisor with PFM. She presented a thorough overview of the Tax Anticipation Notes (TANs) Series 2020. These were issued on July 28, 2020 to provide funds to pay the operational expenditures of the District during the 2020-21 fiscal year, pending the collection of ad valorem taxes and certain state funds and to pay costs of issuance.

The next item on the agenda was presented by Mr. David Moore, Financial Advisor with PFM. He presented an overview of the Debt Management Policy. This policy establishes parameters and guiding principles for governing the issuance, management, continuing evaluation of and reporting all debt obligations issued by The School Board of Broward County. He also discussed its purpose, the decision to issue debt on a case-by-case basis, specific parameters and the District's report card.

The last item on the agenda was presented by, Ms. Laura Howe, Financial Advisor with PFM. She reviewed Moody's Methodology Changes with the Committee.
