Is a standard made of 12 guidelines

Perceivable Operable Understandable

- Level AA mid range deals with the biggest and most common barriers for disables users
- Backgrounds should not compete with buttons, links, text on images or any web page elements
- Any and all non-text content such as images, video and audio need clear and concise descriptions
- Ability to navigate with keyboard
- A "skip navigation" option is also required
- Making video accessible. Closed captioning and detail description of the action is required
- Easy to find information proper heading structure and titles alt text and descriptive link text
- All PDF's and the non text labeled
- No flashing, timers, fly out menus, no pop-ups
- Is the content organized, navigated with out a mouse and taking into account disabilities
