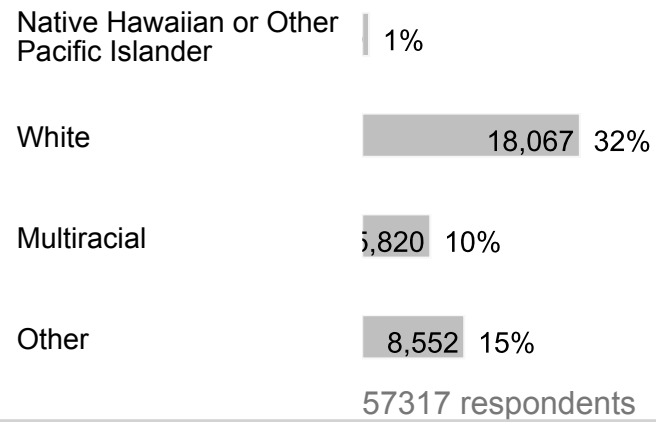

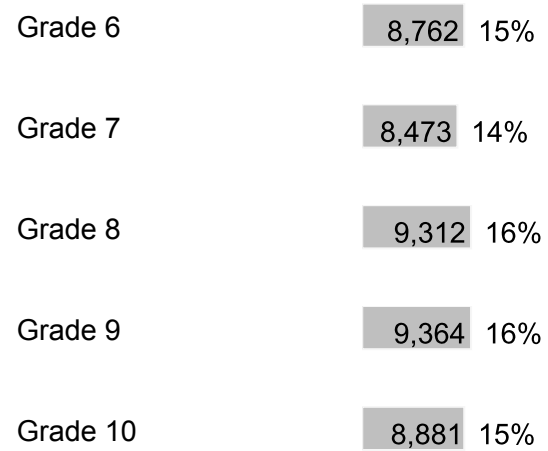

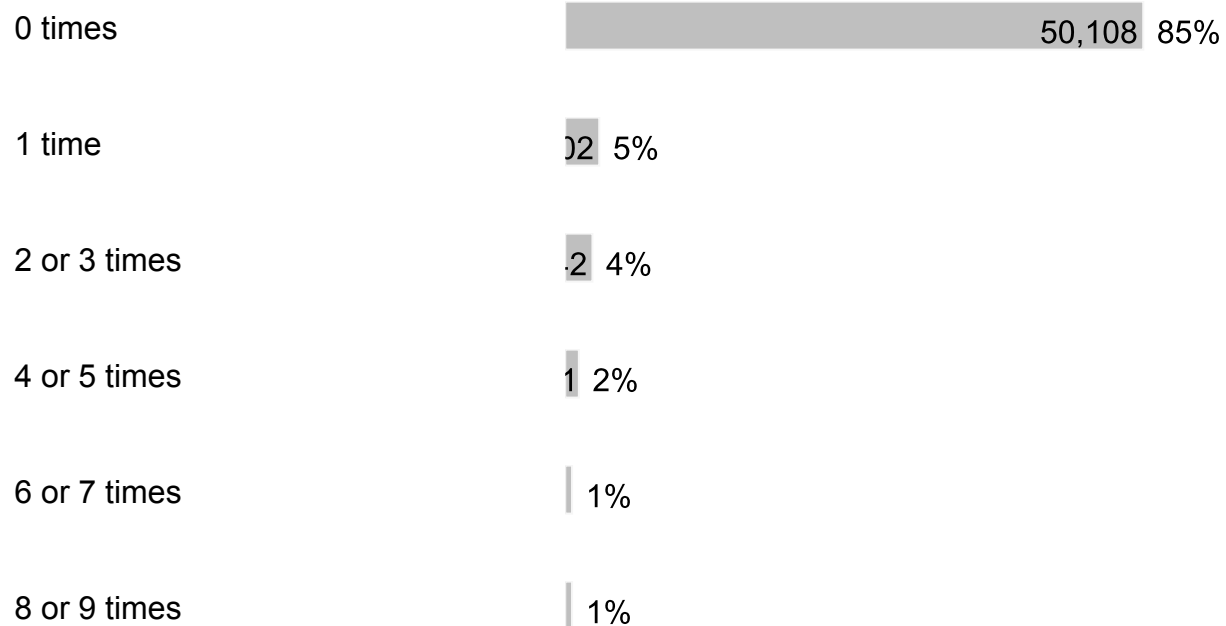

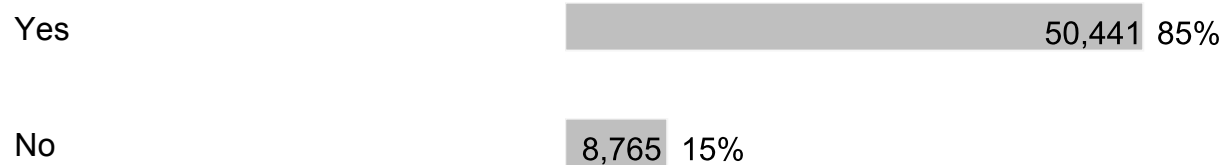

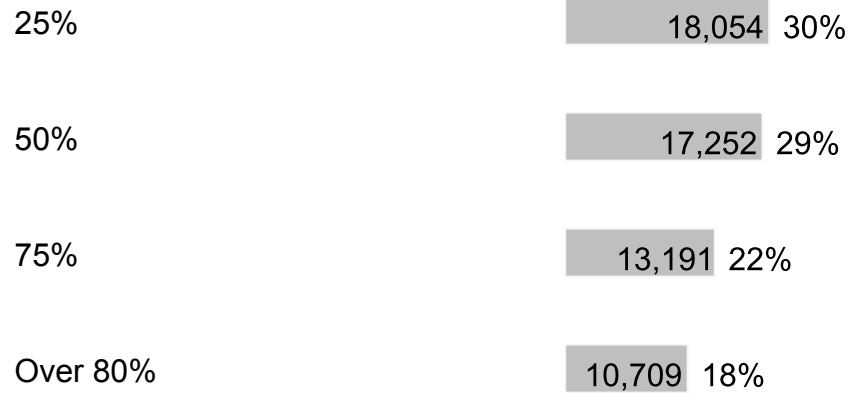

21. I believe drinking alcohol is bad for your brain.



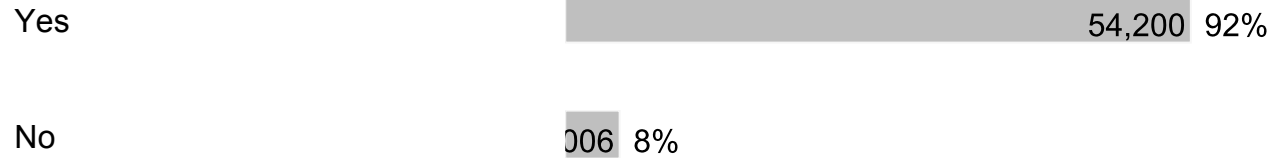

22. In your opinion, what percentage of Broward County students in grades 6 - 12 choose not to drink alcohol?



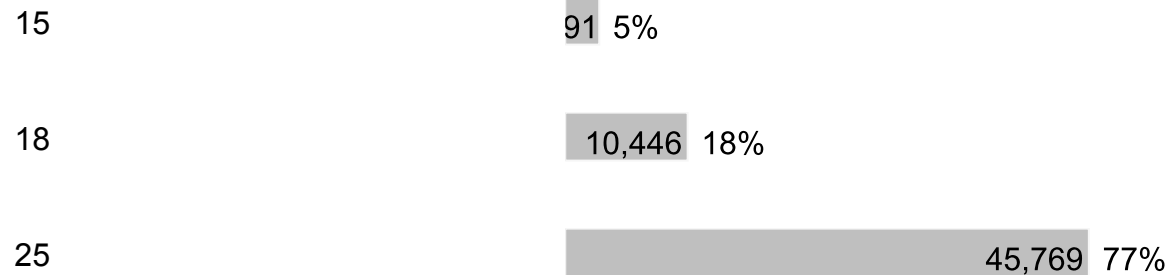

23. I believe using drugs are bad for your health.



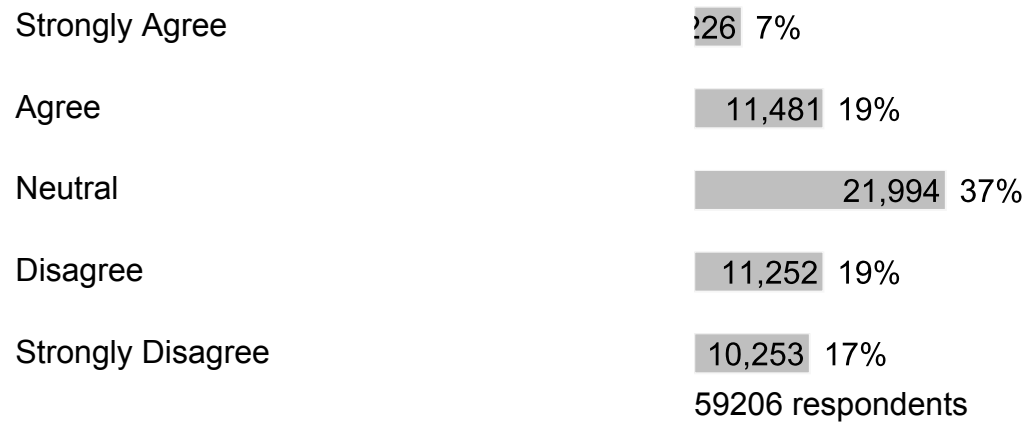

24. At what age is a human brain fully developed?



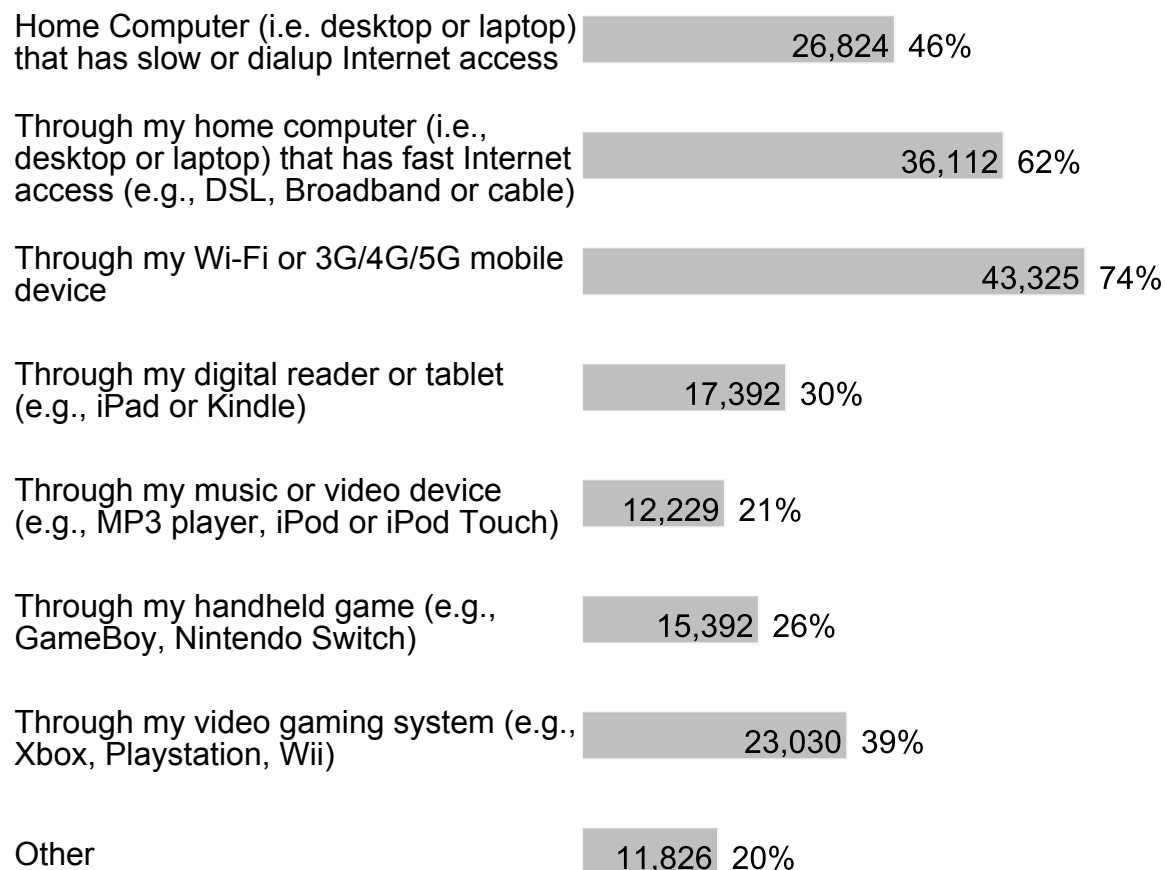

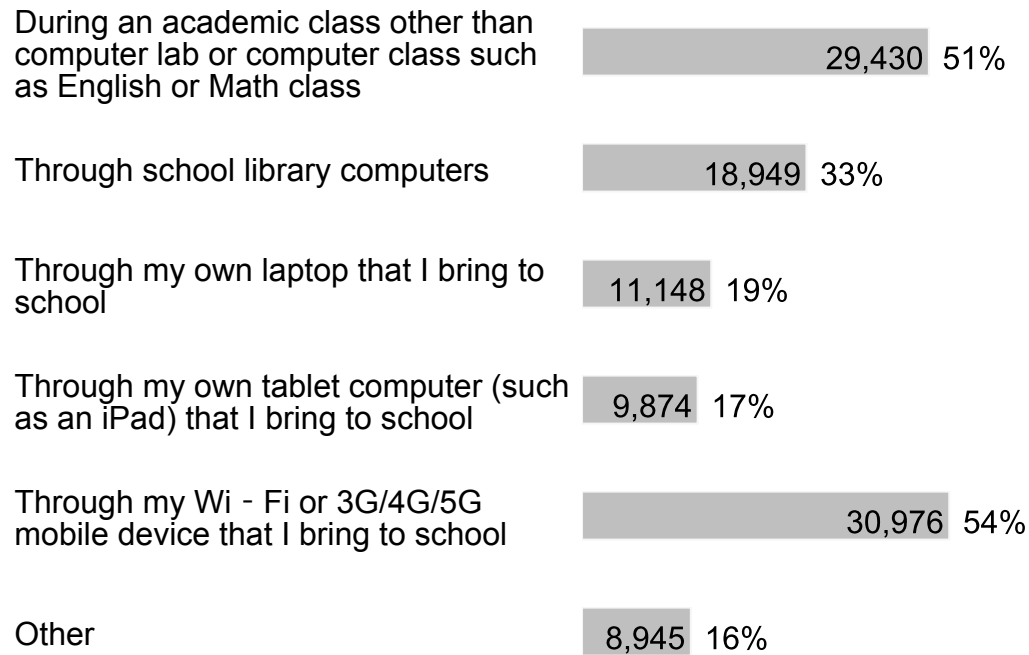

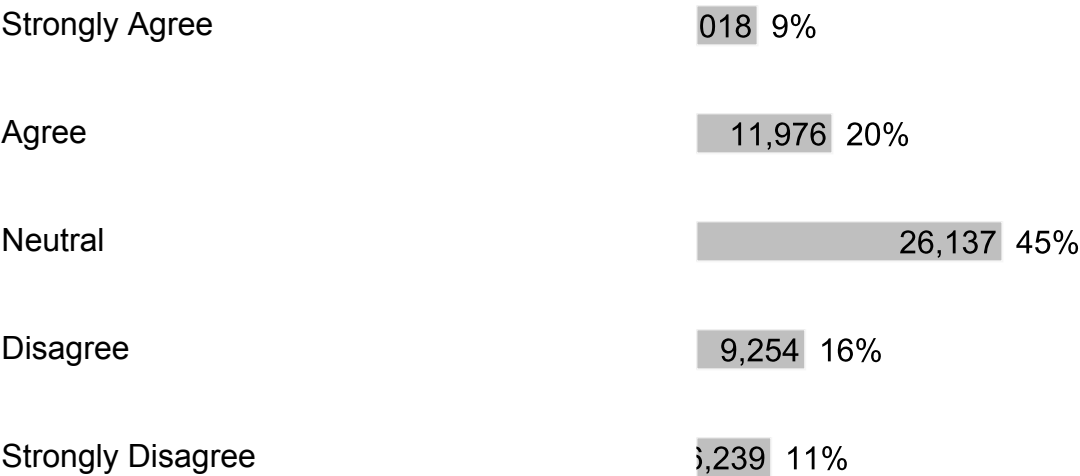

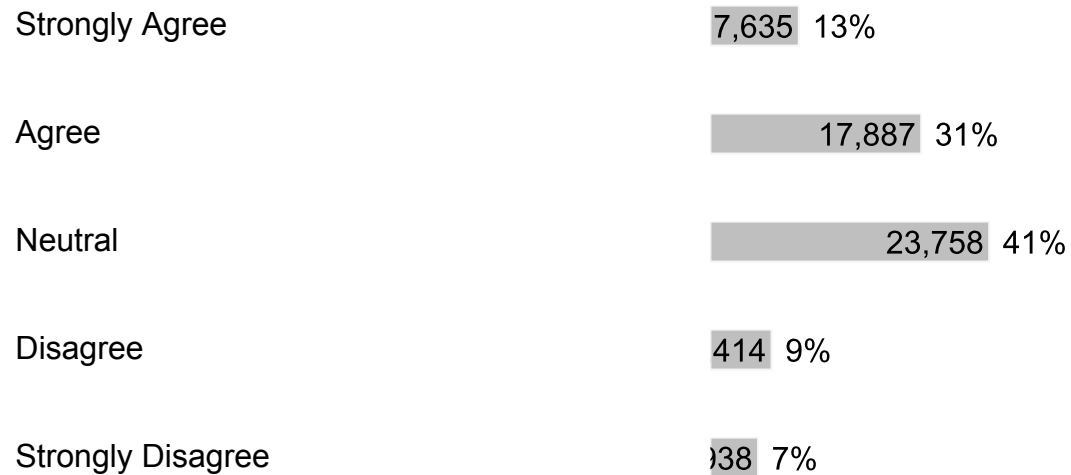

2. In my school, students treat adults with respect.



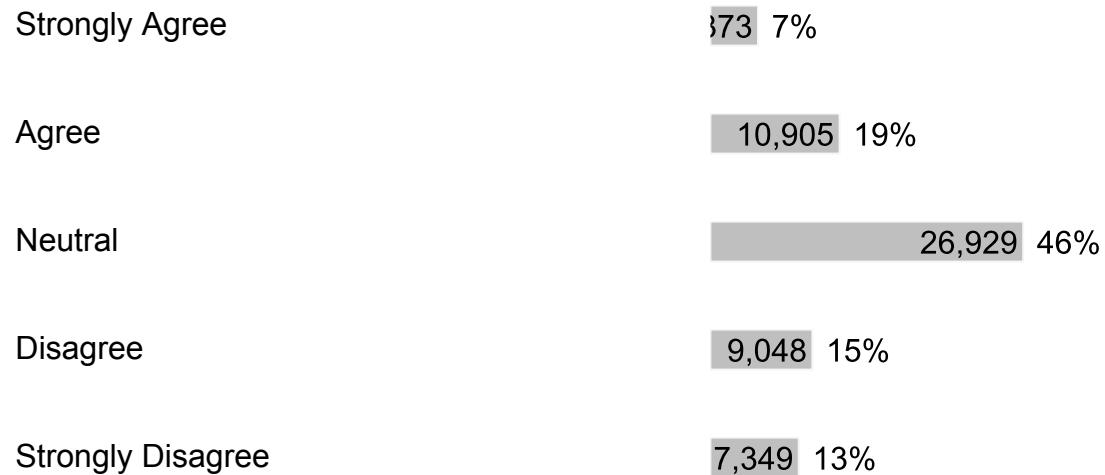

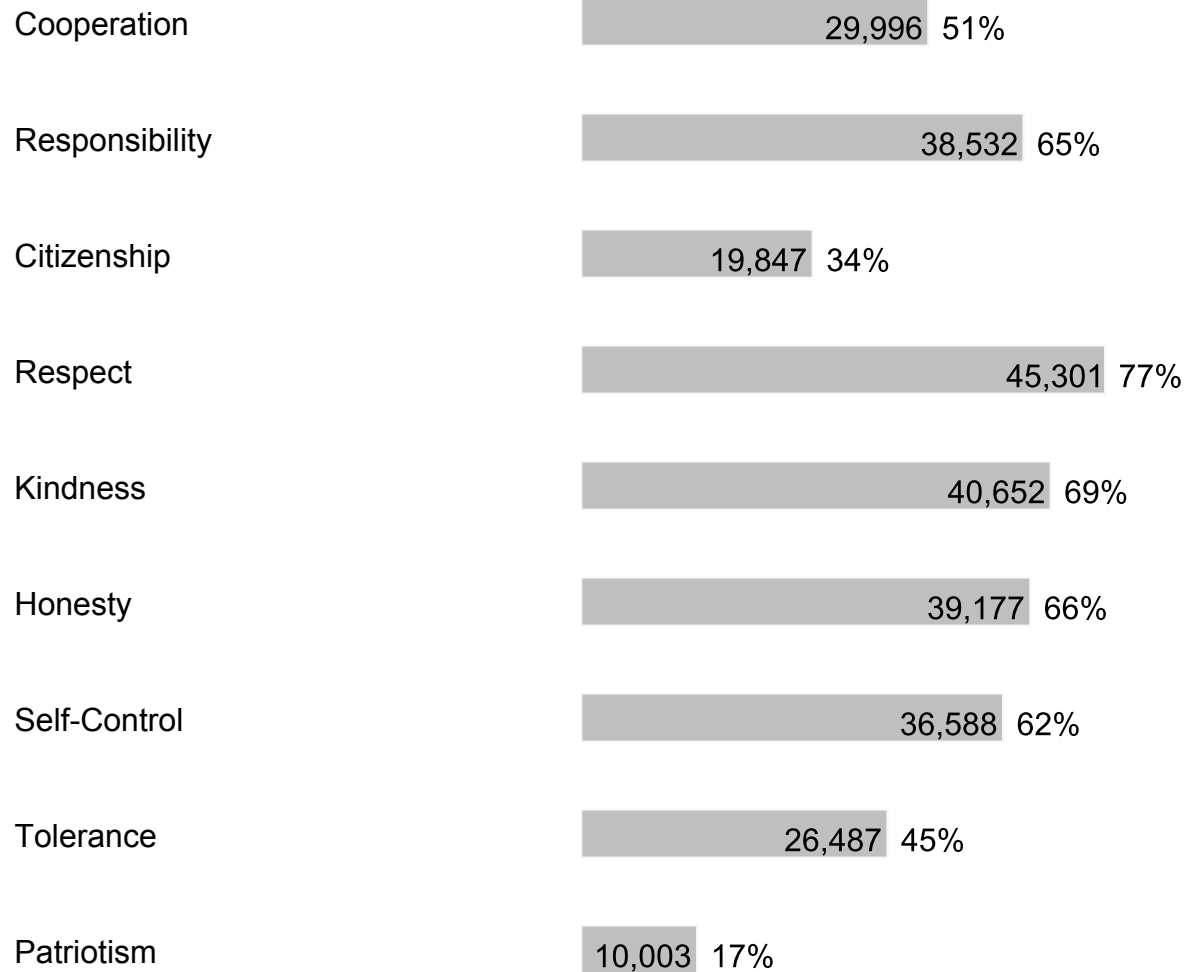

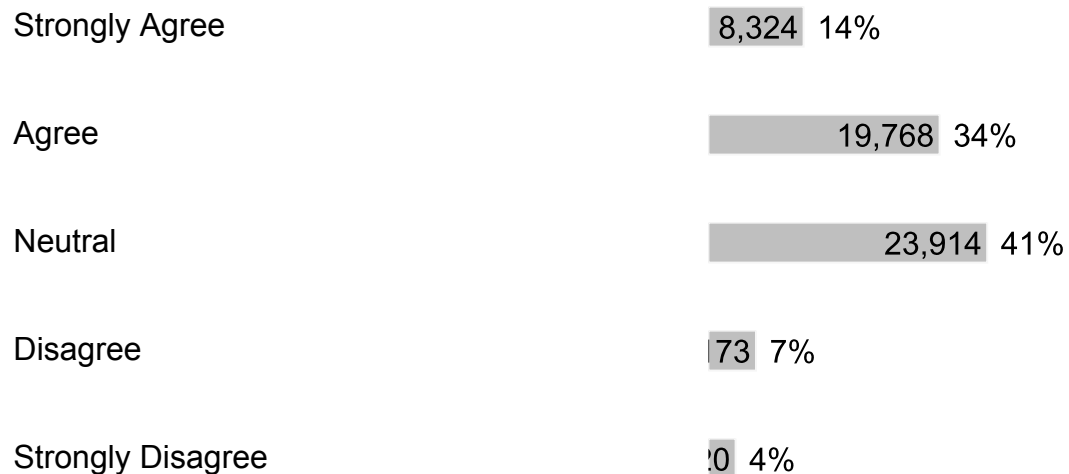

10. Which character traits do you value the most in yourself and others? (check all that apply)



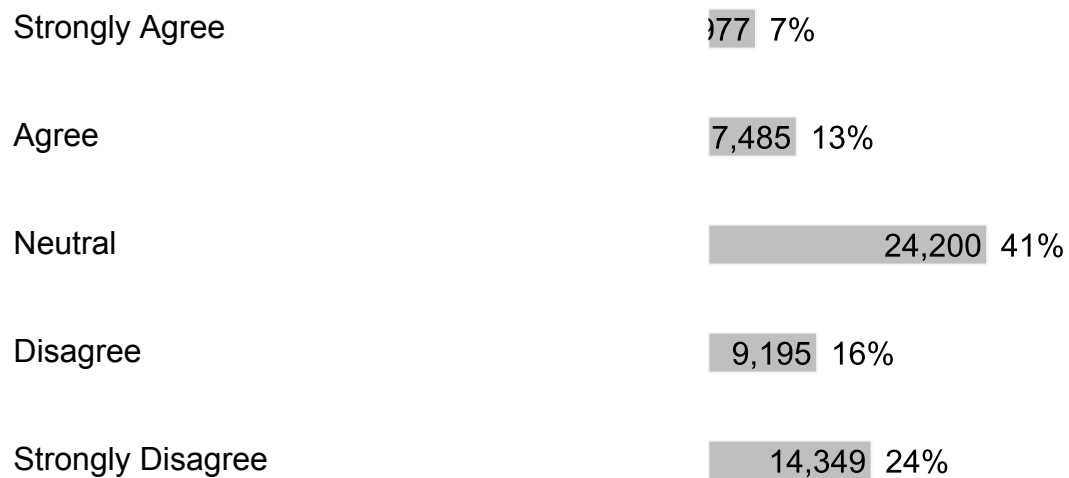

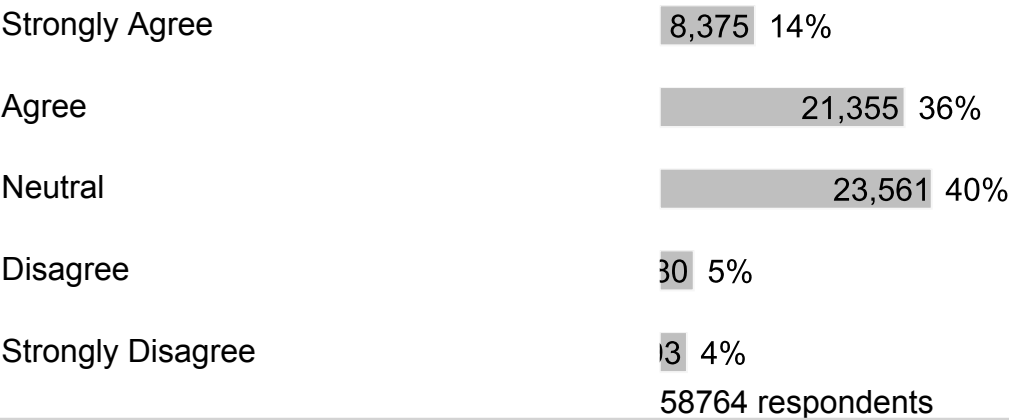
12. I enjoy eating food prepared by the cafeteria.



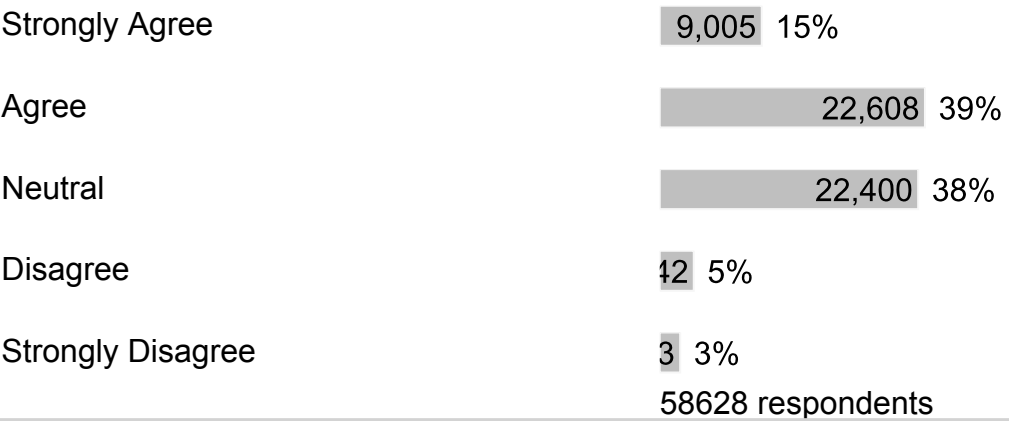

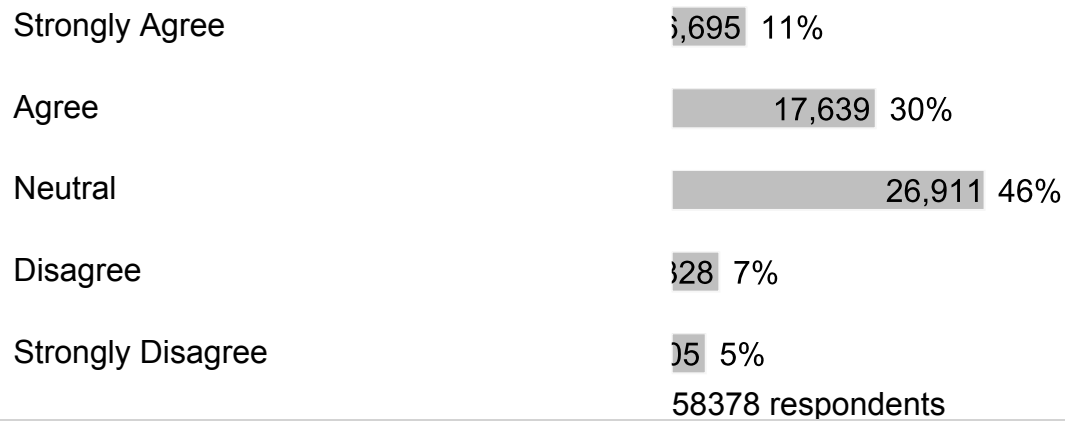

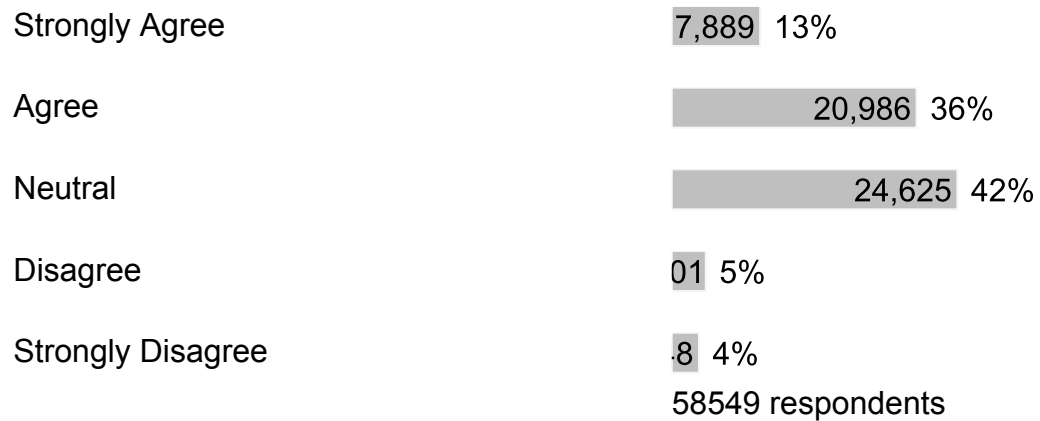
