

2021-22 Schoolwide Improvement Plan Mid-Year Reflection



This guide provides step-by-step directions for school leaders to complete the Mid-Year Reflection with the Schoolwide Improvement Plan.

The purpose of the **Mid-Year Reflection** is to facilitate discussion with school leadership to monitor and assess the progress being made in the Area(s) of Focus targeted within the Schoolwide Improvement Plan (SIP). Schools and districts are strongly encouraged to collaborate with the Bureau of School Improvement Field Team to assist with this process.

The Mid-Year Reflection is performed on the most recently edited version of your plan and addresses each Area of Focus described in the SIP.

The Mid-Year Reflection is available to schools on the plan dashboard of the SIP. Click on the magenta Reflection button to access and complete your Mid-Year Reflection.



Steps to Complete the Mid-Year Reflection

Step 1: When you click on the magenta Reflection button, the Reflection Index page will show the Area(s) of Focus targeted within your SIP. Click blue Edit button to complete the series of questions for each Area of Focus.


