Steps to Complete the Mid-Year Reflection

(Complete each step below for each goal in your SIP)

Step 1: In BCPS Central, click on School Improvement Plan.



Step 2: Scroll down to the Goals, Strategies & Activities section.



Step 3: Complete steps 3 - 5 for each goal by clicking on the "Edit Mid-Year Reflection".



Step 4: For each goal, choose the best option below to complete the Mid-Year Reflection questions.



If the answer is "No" to the first question and "No" to the second question, you are saying:

- You are not on target for meeting your goal and
- You are not making progress towards your goal.

Respond to the subsequent questions. The reflection for this goal is complete. Continue to step 5.



If the answer is "Yes" to the first question, the second question defaults to "No" and there is no need to change the toggle. You are saying:

- Your data shows an upward trend and
- You are on target to meet your goal.

Respond to the subsequent questions. The reflection for this goal is complete. Continue to step 5.



If the answer is "No" to the first question and "Yes" to the second question, you are saying:

Step 5: Make sure to click the *Save* button at the bottom of the screen.


This guide provides step-by-step directions for school leaders to complete the Mid-Year Reflection with the School Improvement Plan.

Schools and districts are strongly encouraged to collaborate with the Bureau of School Improvement Field Teams for schools that receive a school grade, school improvement rating or DJJ accountability rating to assist with this process.


The Mid-Year Reflection is performed on the most recently edited version of your plan and addresses each Area of Focus described in the SIP.

The Mid-Year Reflection is available to schools on the plan dashboard of the SIP. Click on the magenta **Reflection** button to access and complete your Mid-Year Reflection.




Steps to Complete the Mid-Year Reflection

Step 1: When you click on the magenta **Reflection** button, the Reflection Index page will show the Area(s) of Focus targeted within your SIP. Click blue **Edit** button to complete the series of questions for each Area of Focus.




Step 2: The next screen shows the specific Area of Focus as well as its Intended Outcome. Using the toggle, as indicated by the arrow, answer the two questions that address progress being made towards the Area of Focus. The answers to each of these questions will determine the follow up questions for each Area of Focus.



Step 3: Answer the subsequent questions that appear based on your answers to the two toggle questions.



Step 4: After completing the series of questions, make sure to change each Area of Focus from the orange **Editing** to the green **Complete** using the toggle near the top of the screen.




Step 5: Complete the steps above for each of the school's Area of Focus. When the reflection for each one has been completed, the Reflection Index page will change the status to **Complete**.
