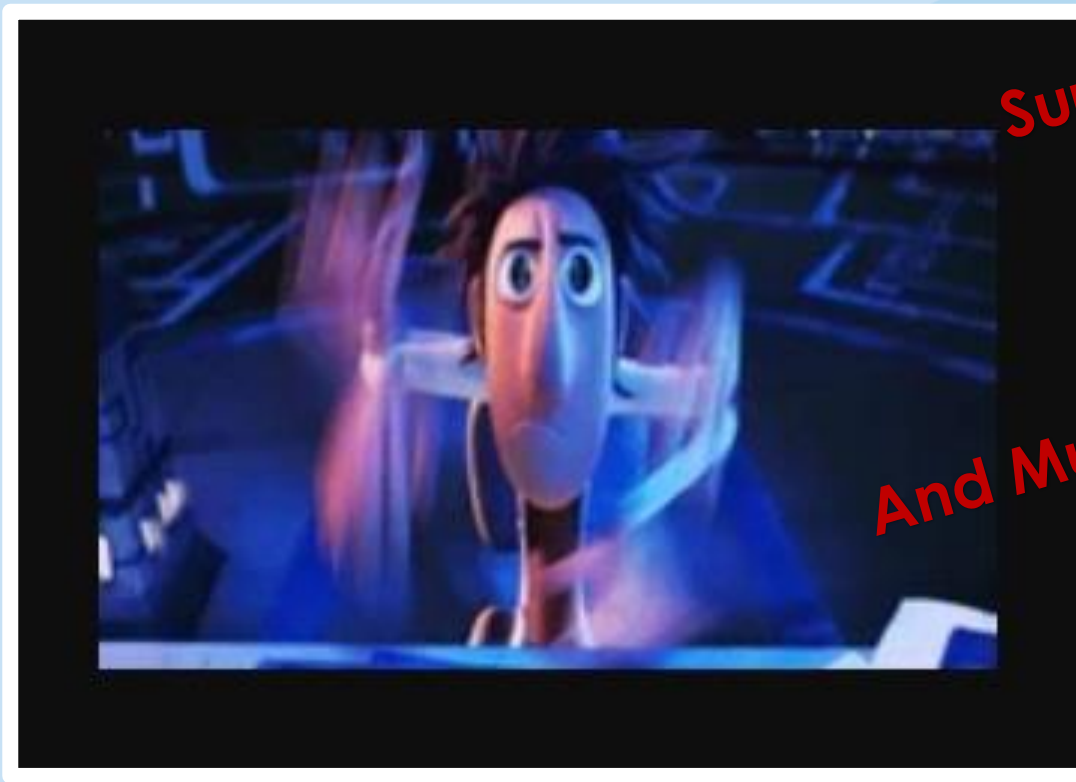

School Improvement Plan

The School Advisory Council shall be the sole body responsible for final decision-making at the school relating to implementation of ss. 1001.42 (18) and 1008.345 as follows:

- Each School Advisory Council shall assist in **the preparation and evaluation** of the school improvement plan.
- Each School Advisory Council is responsible for **monitoring the implementation** of the school improvement plan.
- The school's leadership is responsible for **providing quarterly student performance data reports** to facilitate formative evaluation of the school improvement plan and revision of the action plan.

SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL BYLAWS REVIEW

- School Advisory Council (SAC) must review and revise the Bylaws annually using the SAC Bylaws program in Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) Central.
- Once the Bylaws have been revised and approved by SAC, upload the document in the SAC Documentation Upload Center in the BCPS School Improvement Plan.
- Schools must post the SAC Bylaws on their website and maintain a hard copy in the main office for public access.



BYLAWS ANNUAL REVISIONS

The following Articles/Sections reflect the selections (in orange) the School Advisory Council can revise and adopt.

- Article III - Section 3. Length of Term: Members of the School Advisory Council shall be elected for (ONE, TWO or THREE) year term(s).
- Article IV - Section 1. Officers of this committee will consist of (A CHAIRPERSON or CO-CHAIRPERSONS) and Secretary.
- Article IV - Section 2. The officers shall be elected annually at the (AUGUST, SEPTEMBER, OCTOBER, NOVEMBER, APRIL, MAY or JUNE) meeting.
- Article IV - Section 3. Installation of new officers will be held at the (FIRST or SECOND) meeting of the school year.



SAC BYLAWS & COMPOSITION FIELD TRIP



SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL (SAC) MEETING REQUIREMENTS

SAC Meetings:

- Must be held physically at school sites
- Scheduled on the first and fourth weeks of the month only (Public Engagement Loop)*
- Must be at a convenient time and location for all stakeholders
- Follow Roberts Rules of Order*
- Subject to the Florida Sunshine Law*
- Advertised at least 3 days in advance via the school website, marquee, Parent Link, social media, etc.
- Flyer/notice must plainly state the full name of the School Advisory Council, agenda, time and location.

SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL (SAC) MEETING REQUIREMENTS

SAC Must:

- Collaborate and establish agendas prior to advertising meetings
- Follow and discuss the approved agenda items
- Use the [SAC Agendas Template](#), [SAC Minutes Template](#) , and [SAC Sign-in Sheets](#) (in the new online SAC Composition Program in the SAC Documentation section of the 2022-23 District SIP)
- Post meeting agendas, sign-in sheets and minutes (in draft form if not yet approved) in the SAC Upload Center monthly as PDF documents

SAC Voting:

- Any matter scheduled to come before SAC for a vote requires at least 3 days advance written notice to all SAC members.
- A quorum (51% of total SAC members) must be present before a vote may be taken by SAC.
- Voting must be scheduled early in the agenda.
- Motions, discussion of motions and voting on motions will be by SAC members only.
- All members of SAC have one vote each (even if you hold 2 positions) and must be present in person to vote.

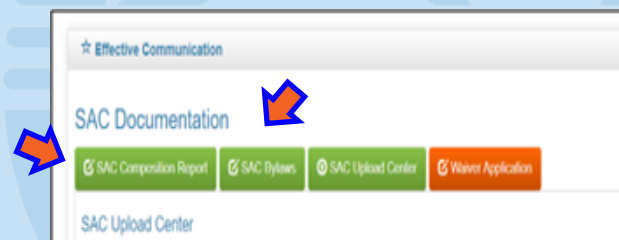

SAC AND SAF COMPARISON

School Advisory Council (SAC)

- Mandated by School Board Policy
- Main purpose is increasing student achievement through school improvement
- SAC Chair(s) can be employee(s) and/or parent
- SAC Chair is a SAF voting member



School Advisory Forum (SAF)

- Mandated by School Board Policy
- Main purpose is communication between stakeholders, the school and the Region Area Advisory Chair
- Members must be parents
- SAF Chair is a SAC voting member

SBBC Policy 1403: In addition to regularly scheduled SAC meetings, joint meetings shall be held semi-annually with the School Advisory Forum (SAF)



SAC & SAF WORK TOGETHER

School Advisory Forum actively participates with the School Advisory Council in identifying the educational needs and priorities of the school.

Both SAC and SAF must record, maintain, and post minutes of all meetings at the school in accordance with the Florida Sunshine Laws.

SAC and SAF indicate awareness of the school budget by the signatures of both chairpersons when it is submitted for district budget preparation.

Both must use district developed guidelines, adopt procedural bylaws, conduct meetings in accordance with the Florida Sunshine Laws & Robert's Rules of Order.

SAF chairperson or designee shall represent SAF as a voting member at School Advisory Council meetings.

In addition to individual School Advisory Forum meetings, SAC and SAF are required by Board Policy to hold semi-annual joint meetings.



SAC/SAF JOINT MEETINGS

The best way to get agenda topics for the two annual joint SAC/SAF meetings is to survey the parents. A simple survey or questionnaire can be an effective way to generate parent interest and give them a voice.

SAC AND SCHOOL FUNDS

The School Advisory Council shall be the sole body responsible for final decision-making at the school relating to implementation of ss. 1001.42(18) and 1008.345 as follows:

- Each School Advisory Council is responsible for allocating **Accountability Funds** to support the school improvement plan goals and objectives. These allocations shall be documented in the school improvement plan and revisions to these allocations must be approved by the School Advisory Council and documented in the Council meeting minutes.
- The School Advisory Council Chair shall sign the **school budget** when it is submitted for district budget preparation as an indication of SAC participation.



ACCOUNTABILITY FUNDS

- SAC approves the expenditures of all Accountability Funds to support the goals and implementation of the School Improvement Plan.
- Outstanding fund balances must be listed on SAC meeting agendas each month until all funds are expended.

Spending Accountability Funds

- The SAC agenda must be detailed and include:
 - The total amount requested
 - A description of the items or services requested
 - The total cost of each item or service
- A quorum, 51% of SAC members, must be met and voting must be conducted early in the meeting.
- The SAC minutes must include:
 - A description of the items or services requested
 - The total amount requested and the cost of each item or service
 - All motions, including maker of the motion, the person seconding, the results of the vote, and any decisions made about spending the accountability funds



FLORIDA SCHOOL RECOGNITION PROGRAM (A+ FUNDS)

The Florida School Recognition Program was created to provide financial awards to public schools that:

- a) Sustain high performance by receiving a school grade of “A,” making excellent progress; or
- b) Demonstrate exemplary improvement due to innovation and effort by improving at least one letter grade; or
- c) Improve more than one letter grade and sustaining the improvement the following school year; or
- d) Are designated as alternative or ESE center schools that receive a school improvement rating of “Commendable” or improve at least one level.

Per the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE), Florida School Recognition Funds will be released within the next couple of months.

We will keep all schools posted as information is released.



School recognition awards must be used for the following:

- a) Nonrecurring bonuses to the faculty and staff
- b) Nonrecurring expenditures for educational equipment or materials to assist in maintaining and improving student performance
- c) Temporary personnel for the school to assist in maintaining and improving student performance.

WAIVER PROCESS



WAIVER RULES

Waiver: Florida law requires each district school board to establish a process by which a school can ask for the setting aside of school-district policy, School Board-approved guidelines, or labor contract article for the purpose of school improvement. Waivers may result in permanent policy or contract changes if proven to be effective solutions to identified barriers.

Only schools that have completed an Intent to Apply Form will be allowed to submit a new waiver application.

➤ **New Waiver Applications**

Must be completed through BCPS Central by February 3, 2023.

➤ **Approval of New Waiver Applications**

Must be approved by the Board in May.

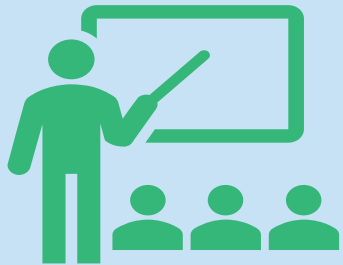

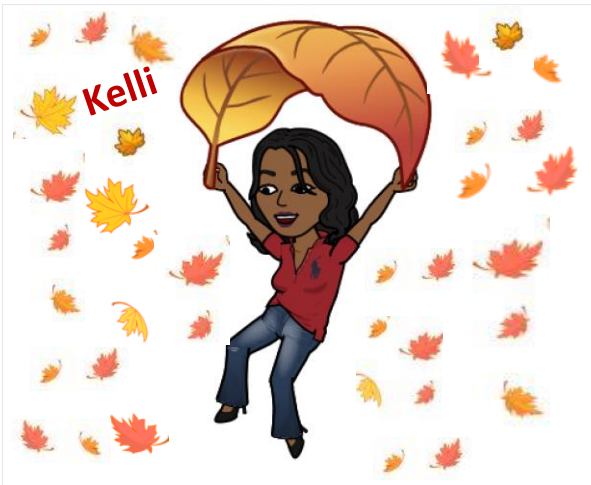
