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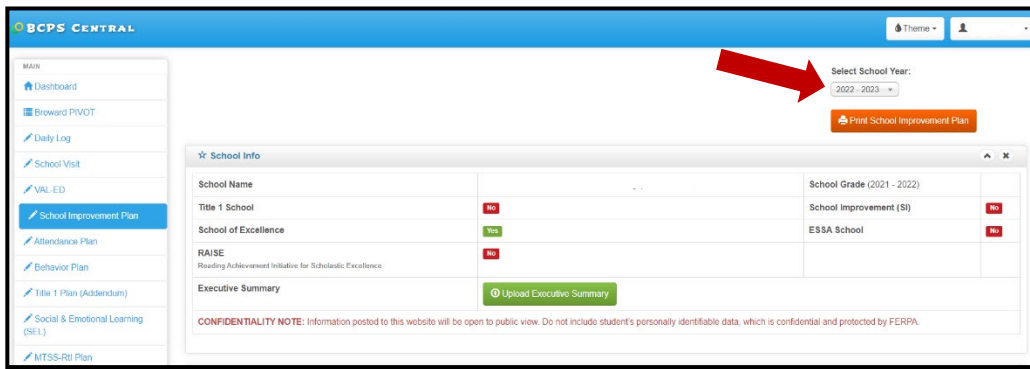

**Step 1:** Log in to BCPS Central @ <https://web01.browardschools.com/ospa/ospa-central2/login.asp>

**Step 2:** Select the 2022-2023 school year from the drop down:
