



## HOW TO APPLY

2024-25 P3 applications and resources at <https://bit.ly/2025P3Applications>

**Schools can apply for all categories to be eligible for the Top Prize, or apply for each category for category prizes**

**NOTE:** The indicators provided in the school rubric are suggestions as to how your school can show evidence of the category. Schools should provide proof of the indicator, e.g. garden pictures, copy of the certificate the school received. Your school can submit other evidence to support your category from what is written in the rubric.

There are 2 ways to send in your school application (you can use both or just the Canvas application):

1) Via **ArcGIS Survey123 app** you can access through your phone or your computer. You can take pictures (real-time) and send them towards your application. You must open up a Canvas application as well. The ArcGIS Survey 123 version is mainly to take pictures from your device towards your application. The Canvas version has all the requirements.

2) Via **Canvas** (<https://bit.ly/2025P3Applications>). We'll create an application page for you under Opened Applications or Collaborations. Send an email to [browardstem@browardschools.com](mailto:browardstem@browardschools.com) with the following information:

(1) Your name and email address (and the names and email addresses of any collaborators) – must be @browardschools.com email address

(2) Nominee's name(s) or school name

(3) School category (1-5 or all) or Stewardship category (educators, students, non-instructional or custodial staff).

Once we receive your info for the Canvas page, look under the Opened Applications or Collaborations links (left side of Canvas) to see your nominee's name (school or stewardship category). You and your collaborators should be able to access the page(s).

What's the difference between the two ways?

ArcGIS Survey123 app - You can take pictures using your phone or tablet and directly send them to support your application. However, your collaborators have to send in pictures via their own account. The Canvas application includes a more complete application process.

Canvas application – you can have collaborators working on the same application but you have to upload the pictures.

### **School Cover Sheet can be submitted via**

1. **Canvas** – Download the cover sheet (next page), complete it and upload via the Assignment page or as a picture attachment to the actual school application.
2. **ArcGIS Survey123** – You can complete and sign the form directly using your device (phone or tablet) – go to <https://arcg.is/11WWSP1> or scan the QR code below:
