- Through an integrated, interdisciplinary approach, the visual arts provide a safe environment for the evolution and resolution of ideas.

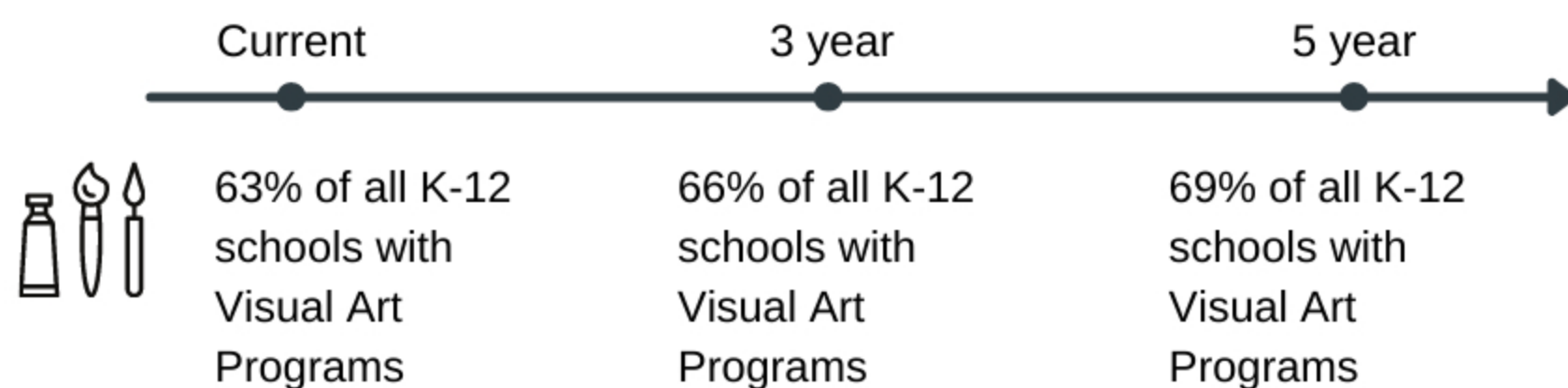


Visual Arts Programs
