Evidence Based Curriculums/Programs

Dating Matters: based off Safe Dates, this 6-7 session curriculum teaches healthy relationship, dating violence prevention curriculum, grades 6-7

Get Real About Violence: an 8-12-week anger management, violence prevention curriculum, grades K-12

LEAPs: an online instrument providing comprehensive lesson plans and interactive multi-modal assessment tools, grades K-12

Safe Dates: a 10 session, healthy relationship and dating violence prevention curriculum, grades 8-10.

Too Good for Drugs and Violence: a curriculum to prevent the use of alcohol and drugs while building skills for decision making, communication, media literacy, conflict resolution, as well as healthy relationships, grades 9-12

Other Dating Violence Prevention Curriculum

The ABCs of Bullying Prevention Book: contains 3 bullying prevention lessons for every grade level, K-12

Anti-Defamation League: anti-bias education to create inclusive and violence free schools, grades K-12

Be the 1 Positive School Culture Initiative: a 3-year outline and tools to help schools establish schoolwide, classroom and individual interventions for violence prevention, grades K-12

BCPS Dating Violence Policy 5010 Training Modules: mandatory annual trainings for BCPS staff, students and parents, grades K-12

Character Education: monthly character newsletter with activities, lessons, and videos, grades K-12

Coaching Boys to Men: a coaching resource to promote respectful behavior and prevent relationship abuse, harassment, and sexual assault, grades 9-12

Dating/Domestic Violence Days/Weeks/Months of Observance: raise awareness with toolkits and lessons at [BrowardPrevention.org](#), grades K-12

FL Coalition Against Domestic Violence: Web based training modules for instructors and downloadable teen dating violence prevention curriculum consisting of eight 45-minute sessions, grades 7-12

The Health Teacher: curriculum with numerous lessons related to health including bullying, grades K-12

Love is Respect: a wide variety of resources including videos, fact sheets, curriculum, and toolkits, grades 6-12

One Love, #ThatsNotLove: provides sets of short videos with lessons (Because I Love You, Behind the Post, Couplets, Love Labyrinth) to shine a spotlight on unhealthy or emotionally abusive relationship behaviors, grades 5-12

Planting the Seeds of Prevention Book: contains 3 dating violence prevention lessons for every grade level, grades 1-12

Sanford Harmony: a SEL teaching program cultivating strong classroom relationships between students, grades PreK-6

Teaching Tolerance: curricula, classroom activities, DVDs, and Film kits, grades K-12
