The District partnered with Evolution Labs to provide Mental and Emotional Health Instruction using the Suite360 curriculum to address the required topics. The curriculum was integrated into the district's learning management system, Canvas, to include additional operability, student checks for understanding, supplemental resources, and reportability.

Each school's leadership team determined which courses and staff were selected to deliver the instruction on their campus. A train-the-trainer model was employed to provide professional development on the use of the Canvas/Suite 360 tool, implementation of best practices, and how to access additional professional development for mental health.

Selected staff assigned their students the required modules within Canvas. The table below outlines the specific lessons delivered and supplemental materials available. Instruction was provided both in-person and through remote learning to ensure all students had the opportunity to complete the lessons.

Mental health practitioners (e.g., school counselors) and crisis support staff (i.e., Talk App) were available

during instruction in the event interventions were needed.

The District partnered with Evolution Labs to provide Mental and Emotional Health Instruction using the Suite360 curriculum to address the required topics. The curriculum was integrated into the district's learning management system, Canvas, to include additional operability, student checks for understanding, supplemental resources, and reportability.

Each school's leadership team determined which subject areas and staff were selected to deliver the instruction on their campus. A train-the-trainer model was employed to provide professional development on the use of the Canvas/Suite 360 tool, implementation of best practices, and how to access additional professional development for mental health.

Selected staff assigned their students the required modules within Canvas. The table below outlines the specific lessons delivered and supplemental materials available. Instruction was provided both in-person and through remote learning to ensure all students had the opportunity to complete the lessons.

Mental health practitioners (e.g., school counselors) and crisis support staff (i.e., Talk App) were available during instruction in the event interventions were needed.
