**Athletics and Student Activities**

5.1 The athletic facilities at the high school meet the District standards (baseball field, softball field, track, gymnasium, tennis courts) and are in satisfactory condition.

The district standard for track and field surface is rubberized polyurethane system. ~~Over the past 12 years, the district has converted numerous tracks from asphalt to a rubberized polyurethane surface. The renovation of track surfaces has been halted and postponed due to economic conditions. The following track and field re-surfacing projects are postponed: Hollywood Hills, Pompano Beach, South Broward, Stranahan, and J.P. Taravella.~~

Update, 02/03/2023: The district standard for track and field surface is rubberized polyurethane system. As a part of the SMART bond, the following tracks were renovated: Hollywood Hills, Pompano Beach, Stranahan, and J.P. Taravella, along with Cypress Bay, Charles Flanagan, Hallandale, Miramar, Monarch, Plantation, West Broward and Western. With allocated Capital funds our office also resurfaced the following projects:

2014 - 2015: Fort Lauderdale

2020 – 2021: Piper

2021 – 2022: Blanche Ely, Cooper City, Coral Springs, South Plantation

2022 – 2023: Boyd Anderson, Dillard 6-12, Northeast, South Broward

Tracks to be completed in 2023 – 2024 & 2024 – 2025 based on priority: Coconut Creek, Deerfield Beach, Everglades, McArthur, Nova, and Stoneman Douglas.

\*Note: Coral Glades is a city owned and managed facility.

Other enhancements to our district standards:

Baseball: netting, windscreens, re-sodding of the fields, replacement of clay.

Softball: netting, windscreens, re-sodding of the fields, replacement of clay.

Gymnasiums: lighting, scoreboards, flooring, bleachers.

Tennis Courts: resurfacing, relining, pressure cleaning.
