Broward County Public Schools (BCPS)

Human Trafficking Prevention & Intervention MTSS

BCPS works to prevent all forms of violence, including human trafficking.

The District prevents and intervenes with this by providing resources and supports embedded and accessed as a multi-tiered system of supports (MTSS). Resources are provided at the Tier 1 level for all schools/students, Tier 2 level for some schools/students, and Tier 3 level for a few schools/students. Intensive individualized support for a FEW schools or students

Tier 2

Targeted support for SOME schools or students

All resources provided in Tier 1 and Tier 2, plus:

- School Based Intensive Interventions: High intensity referrals for services are made for behavioral emotional assessment, threat assessment, PROMISE Program, as well as community-based agencies or law enforcement.
- Assessment: DPI conducts an assessment with review of data and makes recommendations.

All resources provided in Tier 1, plus:

- Revolving Libraries: Three revolving libraries are available for Prevention Liaisons or Peer Counseling Coordinators to check out for their school. Each library has a set of books with lessons focusing on social and emotional learning (SEL).
- Peer-to-Peer (P2P) Pro-Social Clubs and Trainings: After being trained, Peer Counselors promote and raise awareness by teaching Human Trafficking 101 to their peers in classrooms.
- School Based Interventions: Interventions are made including referral to the School Counselor, community agencies, or the Investigative Designee.
- Specialized DPI Staff Trainings: Specialized human trafficking staff trainings are provided by DPI or community partners.
- Violence Prevention Student Curriculum: Curriculum, PowerPoints, and videos on human trafficking, dating violence, as well as other forms of violence are accessed by BCPS staff in DPI's Sharepoint. Community partners also provide student trainings upon request.
- Materials (posters, brochures, hotline cards): By contacting DPI or going to DPI's SharePoint, schools receive materials to raise awareness.

Tier 1 Universal support for ALL **Broward County Public Schools** or students

- Resolution: The School Board of Broward County passes the Human Trafficking Resolution annually.
- Prevention Liaisons (PL): Each school has a PL trained on human trafficking who is responsible for the dissemination of prevention and intervention curriculums and resources on the 6 strands of prevention (diversity, health and wellness, instructional strategies, substance abuse prevention, violence prevention, and MTSS/Academic and Behavioral Supports).
- Investigative Designee: Each school has an administrator trained annually to receive and investigate bullying and/or dating violence complaints.
- Anonymous Reporting Methods: An anonymous reporting/shout out box is at each school's single point of entry and posters are displayed with the Silence Hurts reporting methods (text, online, or phone hotline).
- Data Collection Methods: Needs and effectiveness of violence prevention efforts are assessed with data from school based surveys, BASIS, YRBS, SESIR, DMS/BMS, and FYSAS. Go to BrowardPrevention.org for a full list.
