Using the health education standards adopted in Rule 6A-1.09401, F.A.C., Student Performance Standards, the instruction for child trafficking prevention will advance each year through developmentally appropriate instruction and skill building.

- b. Awareness of resources, including national, state and local resources;
- c. Prevention of the abuse of and addiction to alcohol, nicotine, and drugs;

- e. Information on how social media and mobile device applications are used for human trafficking.



BCPS works to ensure that every school in Broward is a Child Trafficking Free Zone. Each school (K-12) received one Child Trafficking Free Zone poster for a designated ambassador to support student needs as appropriate. Secondary schools received multiple Human Trafficking infographic posters to be displayed in prominent locations throughout the school campus.

The District worked with Evolution Labs to provide Child Trafficking/Internet Safety instruction through the Suite360 curriculum platform to cover the required topic.

The course is structured to be one classroom lesson. Principals created a plan to administer the prevention education lesson to all students in alignment with the State Board of Education state statute Rule 6A-1.094123 FAC. Selected instructors assigned students the specific required modules via CANVAS (Integrated Learning Management System).
