TEEN DATING VIOLENCE DURING COVID-19

Although our teens are no longer physically attending school and may not able to hang out with their dating partners due to stay at home orders, teen dating violence can still occur. According to Love Is Respect, "one in three adolescents in the U.S. is a victim of [abuse] from a dating partner, a figure that far exceeds rates of other types of youth violence". Teen dating violence is described as a pattern of abusive behaviors used to gain and maintain power and control. The abusive behaviors used could be physical, emotional, verbal, sexual, financial, and digital. At a moment in time when we are all relying on the digital platform to stay in touch, dating violence can be occurring even if teens are staying at home.
