What is Transition?

Transition is:

- Moving children successfully from one grade to another
- Continuing a positive school experience for children and their families



Activities to prepare for Kindergarten

Language Activities

- Use and demonstrate positional words like "on", "under", "in", "out", and "next to".
- Play rhyming word games. Clap the out syllables of words.
- READ, READ, READ to your children everyday.
- Talk to your children, particularly at dinner.



Activities

FINE MOTOR/EYE-HAND COORDINATION:

- Let children use crayons.
- Let children use play dough.
- Let children use finger paints



- Have children practice copying straight lines, circles, and crosses, if they are ready, have them practice writing their names.
- Have children practice drawing basic shape (circle, square, triangle, and rectangle).

Activities

GROSS MOTOR ACTIVITIES:

- Have children practice throwing and catching a ball.
- Have children practice walking a straight line.
- Have children practice jumping in place.
- Have children practice hopping on one foot.
- Have children practice skipping.
- Have children practice walking up and down stairs.
- Children should be able to jump, walk and run with no difficulty!



Activities

NUMBER CONCEPTS:

- Let children play with small blocks and make a tower. Have them count the blocks.
- Let children give you a certain amount of objects, while counting them.
- Have children help you set the table and count the number of plates, napkins, forks, and cups you put down.
- Use words like "more", "less", "greater than", "less then", and the "same".



Finally



- Work with your child using the activities we have discussed.
- Encourage your child to take responsibility and complete tasks independently. Tasks include: dressing, toileting, washing hands, brushing teeth, and putting personal items away.
- Establish a school time schedule: bath time, bedtime, wake-up time, dressing and getting ready for school.
- Be involved in your child's education attend school events and volunteer whenever possible.

Kindergarten Registration

You will need the following when you register your school for Kindergarten:

- Legal proof of age child must be on 5 years old on or before September 1 of the year school is starting
- One of the following must be presented as legal proof of age (birth certificate, passport)
- Proof of address- 2 (telephone or electric bill, voters registration card, notarized statement)
- Updated physical within 12 months before school begins
- Florida Certificate of Immunization
