# Gator Aid - A+ Accountability Funds

Gator Aid Camp is a program for students that that need some extra help to improve their success when taking the FSA. The program takes place twice a week after school during the months of February and March with a total of fourteen sessions.

The total cost of materials, which includes reading for 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade as well as 4th and 5th grade math, is \$1962.98. A motion was made by Linda Kortmansky to approve financing the materials for Gator Aid Camp. Annette Tory seconded the motion. the motion was approved.

Two options were presented for paying the staff that will be teaching Gator Aid Camp. The first option was paying \$45 an hour, or \$630 for each teacher which totals \$7560. The second option was paying \$40 an hour or \$560 for each teacher which totals \$6720. A

motion was made by Linda Kortmansky to approve Option 1. The motion was seconded by LT. Chatman. The motion was approved.

# **ESOL Updates**

CANA Camp is a program that is aimed at helping immigrant students that in the beginning stages of learning the English language. CANA stands for Cultural Academy For New Americans. The camp is paid for by a grant and in order to participate, students need to have immigrant status and be in the ESOL program for under two years and have a level 1 or 2 rating. Currently, Gator Run Elementary has 60 students participating. ESOL Testing will take place starting on January 29, 2019 and needs to be completed and sent in by March 20, 2019. Students in kindergarten through fifth grade with an ESOL label will be participating.

### **Parent Suggestion**

A parent suggested we look at recycling during school-wide events such as Field Day, Spirit Walk, or other events in which disposable water bottles are used in abundance. Administration noted that the idea will be looked into.
