SUBJECT: 2020 – 2021 HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION RATES

On January 4, 2022, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) released Federal graduation rates for Florida and the 67 Florida school districts. State and district data are located online at the FDOE Education Information & Accountability Services Website:

The Chancellor of Public Schools, Jacob Oliva provided the following narrative related to the 2020-21 graduation rate, "Florida's high school graduation rate increased by 0.1 percentage points over the last year and has increased significantly during the past eighteen years. The rate rose from 59.2 percent in 2003-04 to 90.1 percent in 2020-21, which is a 30.9 percentage-point increase. When comparing the 2019-20 and 2020-21 graduation rate to prior years, it is important to note that pursuant to Florida Department of Education Emergency Order No. 2020-EO-1 and Florida Department of Education Emergency Order No. 2021-EO-02, students in the 2019-20 and 2020-21 graduating classes were exempt from statewide, standardized assessment requirements stipulated in s. 1003.4282, F.S. Approximately 8.5% of the 2020-21 graduating class graduated with this exemption, and 7.1% of the 2019-20 graduating class graduated with this exemption." In Broward, 9.9% (1,864 out of 18,909) of the 2020-21 graduating class received a standard diploma as a result of this exemption, and 8.5% (1,672 out of 19,780) of the 2019-20 graduating class.

Highlights from this data include:

- Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) maintained a graduation rate greater than 89% for the second consecutive year.
- BCPS Federal graduation rate is **89.1% in 2020-21**, which is a slight decrease of 0.3 percentage points from 89.4% in 2020-21.
- Black (86.6%, 0.1 percentage point increase from 2019-20) and White (92.7%, 0.3 percentage point increase from 2019-20) students improved their graduation rates. Hispanic rate decreased by 0.9 percentage points to 89.1% from 90.0% in 2019-20.
- The graduation rate gap between English Language Learner (ELL) and Non-ELL students narrowed by 0.3 percentage points to 2.5.

- 35 of 36 traditional District high schools achieved a graduation rate of 90% or higher and 27 of these schools reached a graduation rate at or above 95%.
- Eight District high schools earned 100% graduation rates: Atlantic Technical High School, Broward Virtual Franchise, College Academy at Broward College, Lauderhill 6-12, Millennium 6-12 Collegiate Academy, Pompano Beach High School, Sheridan Technical High School, and William T. McFatter Technical High School. College Academy at Broward College achieved a graduation rate of 100% for the tenth consecutive year.
- Hollywood Hills High School increased its graduation rate by 2.8 percentage points and South Broward High School increased its graduation rate by 2.6 percentage points.
- Florida's Federal graduation rate is 90.1% in 2020-21, which is an increase of 0.1 percentage points from 90.0% in 2019-20.

Subsequent pages provide further detail and analysis including comparison of graduation rates for Florida's five largest districts, graduation rates for the major race/ethnicity groups served in BCPS, and graduation rates by school.

Table 1 displays the historical graduation rates for Florida's five largest districts and the State overall. In 2020-21, Broward had a graduation rate of 89.1. For the second consecutive year Broward's graduation rate is above 89%.




Figure 1. Historical Graduation Rates

Figure 1 illustrates the ten-year historical graduation rates for BCPS traditional District high schools, BCPS Strategic Plan (including high schools and centers), BCPS overall (including high schools, centers and charter schools), and Florida. BCPS traditional District high schools achieved graduation rates that were consistently higher than the state, reaching 96.6% in 2020-21.

Table 2 shows the graduation rates for the major race/ethnicity groups served in BCPS. The graduation rate increased for Black students and White students. In 2020-21, the gap between Black and White students grew slightly by 0.2 percentage points and the gap between Hispanic and White students also increased by 1.2 percentage points compared to 2019-20.

Table 3 shows the graduation rates by special category groups served in BCPS. The graduation rate decreased in all three category groups FRL, SWD, and ELL. Students with Disabilities showed the largest decrease in graduation rate down 2.2 percentages points from 2019-20.

The graduation rate gap between FRL and Non-FRL students increased to 7.6 percentage points up 1.3 percentage points from 2019-20. The gap for SWD and Non-SWD students widened to 8.5 percentage points. The graduation rate gap between ELL and Non-ELL students decreased by 0.3 percentage points to 2.5.

Appendix A shows the graduation rates for BCPS schools from 2016-17 through 2020-21. Review of the appendix shows that **35 of 36 traditional District high schools achieved a graduation rate of 90% or higher.** Hollywood Hills High School increased its graduation rate by 2.8 percentage points and South Broward High School increased its graduation rate by 2.6 percentage points. College Academy at Broward College achieved graduation rate of 100% for the sixth consecutive year.

Appendix B shows the cohort size and graduation rates for the major race/ethnicity groups served in BCPS by school for the 2020-21 graduation cohort.

Appendix C shows the historical graduation rates for 2011-12 through 2020-21 for BCPS by schools.
