#### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Head Start children must be 3-or 4-years-old on or before **September 1, 2021.**
- Early Head Start accepts pregnant women and children birth to 3-years-old.
- Family income must be at or below the US Department of Health & Human Services Poverty Guidelines to qualify for the program.
- Applications must be completed by **parent/guardian ONLY**.

#### **Documents Needed To Apply**

- Proof of age (child's ORIGINAL birth certificate or foreign passport)
- Proof of guardianship, if applicable
- Parent/guardian photo identification (FL Drivers License or Passport)
- Proof of Broward County residence (domicile)
- Proof of ALL HOUSEHOLD INCOME FOR PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR (2020) OR PAST 12 MONTHS

- 2020 Income Tax Form 1040
- 2020 Pay stubs with year-to-date income (for full year)
- 2020 W-2 Forms (for full year)
- Unemployment Compensation Records

- Supplemental Security Income (SSI) <u>Award Letter Only</u> with full payment history for 2020 or last 12 months
