<u>General Considerations for Virtual</u> Students

- Create a space and dedicated time for learning (away from the bed).
- Monitor surroundings to make sure only the student is in the camera.
- Eat breakfast before class time.
- Parents must report absences by calling the school at 754-322-6900.
- Parent/teacher conferences take place outside of student engagement time.
 Parents should not interrupt the learning process with questions. Instead, contact the teacher to set-up a separate meeting outside of instructional time.
- On the third Thursday of each month, we will be hosting a virtual class drive-up. This is when any supplies, birthday goodies, items from the school will be distributed. The pick-ups will take place with primary (PreK-2nd) in the bus loop and Intermediate in the front of the school from 2:30 p.m. until 3:00 p.m.

General Considerations for Face to Face Students

- All Students, Staff and Parents Must Wear a Mask.
- Uniforms are not required, proper attire is.
- Please send your child with a water bottle.
- Everyone must have a dismissal sign.
- Everyone must practice physical distance on the campus.


