



#### **MEETING TIMES:**


- On the day of Grad Bash, you MUST attend ALL OF YOUR CLASSES!
- All students must stay for the duration of 3<sup>rd</sup> period.
  - Those who have B lunch can report to the Main Auditorium starting at 12:30.
  - Everyone else should come right after 3<sup>rd</sup> period ends.
- Bus leaves at 2 PM with or without you!
  - There will be NO REFUNDS for anyone who misses the bus!
- Students must leave the park at 1:30 A.M.
- The buses will depart for Piper High School at 2:00 A.M.
  - Students must be on the bus before 2:00 AM to avoid parents having to provide transportation home for students who did not show at the designated time.
- Buses will return to Piper around 6:30 A.M.




- There will be no smoking, alcohol, drugs, or unauthorized substances on the trip. It is common practice to have Police and K-9 units present in the Main Auditorium at check-in to explore for any illegal substances. Additionally, students who appear to have been drinking or to be under the influence of mood-altering substances before departure time, as evidenced by behavior and/or odor, will not be permitted on the buses.
- Any student who violates the School's Student Code of Conduct and Discipline Code and/or Park regulations will be disciplined according to Universal Park Policies and the Orange County Police Department.
  Parents will be contacted by the appropriate park representatives authorities and possible arrangements will have to be make with them to provide transportation home. Students will also be subject to additional consequences at school, as outlined in the discipline matrix, including but not limited to suspension, expulsion, and possible loss of senior privileges.




- It is recommended that students make arrangements for transportation to and from the school on that day since we cannot guarantee the security of any automobile left in the school parking lots.
- Students are to ride up and back on the same bus.
- Only iPhones / personal cell phones with headsets may be taken onto the buses. Headsets must be used, and if the use of these becomes disturbing to other students, they will be collected by the chaperones and returned at the end of the trip. Broward County Schools, Piper High School and chaperones are not responsible for students' electronic devices.
- Since the buses and Grad Bash tickets have been prepaid, there will be no refunds.
- Tickets are non-transferable.



- Students must adhere to Universal Studios dress code, or they will not be allowed to board the buses. Over-sized bags are not permitted in the park and will have to remain at home or stay on the bus. It is advised that all seniors bring as little as possible as you are responsible for all personal belongings.
- Please refer to Universal's Dress Code Guidelines and expect that Universal Staff WILL intervene if dress code and bag sizes are not in compliance. Trust us on this... you DO NOT want to be in the line at the end of the night trying to re-collect your bags or any other items if they are collected due to lack of compliance.
  - It is suggested that students bring a sweatshirt or a small blanket as the buses tend to be cool.



- Loud and/or boisterous behavior will not be permitted on the buses.
- Cell phones and cameras are permitted but there is to be no flash photography on the buses. At night, something students consider a fun flash shot, may be blinding to the bus driver.
- Please be advised that students may be denied the privilege of participating in field trips or social and/or extra-curricular activities if said student(s) have been disruptive, violate the student code of conduct or fail to conform with school rules and regulations. If any senior is externally suspended during the school year, that senior could be denied the privilege of attending Grad Bash and future senior privileges. In addition, we will refuse this activity to those who are considered potential problems by any of the school administrators or teachers. Grad Bash is an earned privilege and students need to be aware that all of their actions will have consequences.
