ELECTIVE COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

<u>CODING</u>: Do you want to improve your keyboarding skills, learn of the latest technology, and create your own games and programs? Then this course is for you. Learn the why and how computers work to design and create computer programs while learning the latest in technology.

<u>COMPUTERS</u>: Learn how to use Digital Programs while working towards a MicroSoft Industry Certification in Word, Excel, and PowerPoint. Students will complete projects using a variety of multi-media. What you learn will help you earn!
