Principal Updates- Ms. Sabine Phillips

1. Interims

- Appearing on Virtual Counselor today.
- Mrs. Phillips explained this is the halfway mark of Quarter 2.
- Live grades are always accessible through Pinnacle.
- Folders were given out to parents with directions on how to access Virtual Counselor.

2. Smart Bond Update

- Currently finishing the 20 portables to enter Phase 1 of repairs: air condition and roof.
- School will be done in sections; classrooms will be temporary held in the portables until the section is finished.
 - Portable section is complete with walk way, camera, and air conditioning unit.
- Work order for the bathroom, media center, and art room.
- Out of all the middle schools in Broward, Margate Middle has the second smallest cafeteria and we need to enlarge to accommodate the amount of students.
 - Ms. Phillips shared a QR code for parents to enter their information to be emailed with ways to help the school with cafeteria repairs.
 - In 2005, there were plans of construction for the school but it was put on paused.
- Staged floor was repair but not the front of the stage. Ms. Phillips stated that a different department is in charge of that; so a work order was submitted.

3. School & Student Goals

- 50% Learning Gains/50 % Proficiency= 100% GREATNESS

4. School Data

- Mrs. Phillips reviewed and compared the FSA 2022 and FAST 2023 Data.
- The difference between proficiency and learning gains were explained to parents.
 - Proficiency- student achieves a 3 or higher in the FAST/EOC assessment.
 - Learning gains- the increase in points a student achieves from PM 1 to PM 3.
- Extended Learning Opportunities will start soon to help students merge the learning gap.

5. Progress Monitoring Incentives for PM 2

- Incentives will be given to students who achieve learning gains from PM1 to PM 2.
 - 10 Points- Pizza Party
 - 20 Points- Open Gym (2 Hours) with Barbeque Burgers & Hot Dog
 - 30 Points- Full Day Field Day (Color Wars)
