School Advisory Council and Committee- Ms. Ambar Fernandez

- 1. Introduced SAC and explained policy 1403: School accountability and improvement.
- 2. SAC Composition: introduced school member representatives and introduced the positions that are open for parent member representatives. Explained

Principal Updates- Ms. Sabine Phillips

- 1. Open house is Thursday, September 7, 2023 at 6:30 PM.
- 2. Next week we are starting PM1.
- 3. Ms. Phillips explained how the test is broken into three parts and how each set of data is used.
 - Students should make gains from PM1-PM3.
- 4. Soccer tryouts started today and will continue tomorrow. Cross country and golf will also start this week.
- 5. Margate has been working really hard to balance out schedules.
 - We are working with the district to have students who have not shown up for the first dropped from the system.
 - Having those students in the system messes up the numbers and make it hard to balance classes.
- 6. Field trip at MSD Nature Center for 6th grade on October 6 for 100 students.

- 1. Mr. Daniel spoke about the fire drills and codes.
- 2. He also spoke about ID pictures, students without an ID will take pictures over the next three weeks. Students also should bring in

Special Presentation 'Parent University'- Guidance Department

- 1. Ms. Williams, Dr. Reynolds, Ms. Fernandez presented for parent university.
- 2. Ms. Williams introduced the guidance team and gave out grade levels, emails, conference information, and duties.
- 3. Middle school requirements were discussed, students must pass three courses of math, science, social studies, and language arts. Civics is a 7th grade course with an EOC exam.
- 4. Course recovery is done at the end of every year to help students catch up. Discussed the point system, how each letter is worth, and that students need a 2.0 to play sports.
- 5. Course selection: if students scored a level 1 or 2, they will get a reading and/or math class as an elective. If the student is in high school courses, they are starting their high school gpa and should

- only be in those classes if they are earning a B or higher.
- 6. Dr. Reynolds further explained the high school courses and how many As and Bs are needed to get a 4.0 3.0. Every high school course, including electives, has an end-of-course (EOC) exam which is worth 30% of their final grade. FAST: September, December, and May.
- 7. Dr. Reynolds discussed which courses have a midterm and end of year exam.
- 8. Ms. Fernandez spoke about pinnacle and virtual counselor.
 - It is important that parents check both daily and gave tips for success for parents and students.
- 9. A parent asked what time conferences are held.
 - The answer was Wednesdays and Thursdays @ 8:20 AM and 8:45 AM and may not include elective teachers. Phone conferences can also be requested.
- 10. In the packet there are conversation starters for the parents, this will encourage conversation between parents and students.
