Dear Parents/Guardians:

This is to inform you that if you answer “YES” to ANY of the three questions located at the bottom of the registration form labeled “Home Language Survey,” your child WILL be given an English Language Proficiency assessment. The results of that assessment will determine if your child is identified as an English Language Learner (ELL) student who qualifies for participation in the English Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) program.

Enrollment into the ESOL program is NOT OPTIONAL. Federal Law mandates the enrollment of all ELL students into the ESOL program based on the results of the initial assessment. ELL students do not need to speak another language to qualify for the program.
