Hello and thank you for being here tonight.

Grades 3-8 and staff take the BCPS Customer Survey. A parent link will be sent home tomorrow regarding the survey. It will also be posted on the school website.

Information regarding Spring Testing:

- Florida is not an opt-out state.
- Testing will only occur at school. The state of Florida does not allow for testing at home or another non-school site.
- If the student is not physically present at school for the exam, the student will be marked absent.
- The district will provide transportation for eligible students on the dates those students need to come into school for testing. Parents can also provide transportation. Survey available today for eligible students.
- Dates for testing will be released shortly (for the first round of tests: 3 rd grade ELA and writing for grades 4-8). At a later date you will get the remaining testing dates for 3-8 Math, 4-8 ELA, 5th/8th grade Science, and EOCs (Biology, Geometry, Civics). They will all be administered in May.

Lion's Den has begun for some grades, the other grades will begin this week. Lion's Den is test prep in the morning before school. It is funded by the district/state, therefore we do not have to use accountability funds.

Ten teachers from the district have assumed teacher responsibilities here at Beachside. It has been running smoothly.

The dance-a-thon started today. This is our only fundraiser this year. The focus of raising money will be for improvements to the PreK/Kindergarten/First grade playground. The sand will be replaced with rubber. The 2/3 playground will get upgrades as well. The re has been an anonymous \$20,000 donation from a family. Thank you to them for the generous donation.
