- > Early Warning Indicators- school based interventions were discussed
- ➤ BEST practices- Goals, Strategies, Activities were discussed, I-Ready Reading and Math, standards-based instruction
- > Parental input was solicited but no input was given
- School-Level Parent and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP)
 - Engagement goal: strategies and objectives were discussed for creating an environment or culture that engages families with the school
 - Parental input was solicited but no input was given
- Positive Behavior Intervention & Support (PBIS)
 - > Flamingo Dollars are given out by teachers 2 per day and students shop every 3 weeks
 - > Flamingo Feathers are given in the hallways and during specials and rewards will be given to classes that meet the goal
 - Cafeteria points are announced on morning announcements daily and rewards are given monthly
 - > SEL- Mrs. Padron shared that students are encouraged to chat at lunch with sentence frames that are taped on the tables
- ❖ Title I Addendum 2019-2020- Mrs. Velasquez is the liaison and explained there are 47 compliances, this addendum was developed, parental input was solicited but no input was given

- School Uniform Policy- the policy was reviewed, offenses were described by a parent, Mrs. Arroyo stated that leggings were okay if worn under a skort, Mrs. Padron suggested asking families to donate gently used uniforms at the end of the year, Mr. Bullock proposed giving a positive reward for classes that are in uniform (Flamingo Feathers) as opposed to penalizing students for not being in uniform, Mrs. Lakhani suggested brining up at the PTO meeting to see if they can offer an additional incentive
