



 - 2. Diploma Pathway- Obtaining Cambridge Diploma










Cambridge International AS Level = one credit

Cambridge International A Level = two credits


Learners can accumulate credits for the Diploma over a 25-month period.








College Credits






Can I take the AP Capstone program and Cambridge? Yes, and we can work on a schedule to do both.

When do students take AICE examinations?

The majority of our students will take AICE examinations in May/June. Please note, several AICE examinations take **place** after the regular school year has ended, but absolutely are still required.

What if I miss an AICE examination?

There is no make-up examination within the same testing session; therefore, the candidate would need to retake the test the following session in the next school year
